Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

Our charge includes funeral counseling, consultation with family and celebrant, necessary arrangements, recording of vital statistics, securing permits, filing and obtaining death certificates and other forms and claims, preparation and filing of newspaper obituaries and other necessary notices, and coordination of service plans with other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangement you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Care of the Decedent

- Transfer of Remains to Funeral Home (within 40-mile radius) \$350
(Transfer of Remains beyond a 40-mile radius will be charged at \$3.00 per loaded mile)
- Embalming \$800
Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
- Other Preparation of the Body – Washing, Disinfection, Cosmetology and Dressing \$250
- Special Care of Autopsied Remains \$300
- Special Care of Organ/ Tissue Donor Remains \$300

Alternative containers encase the body and may be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are heavy cardboard and leak resistant. You may provide your own acceptable container.

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In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require you to purchase a container to surround the casket in a grave. However, many cemeteries require you to have such a container so that the grave will not continue to settle. Either a grave liner or burial vault will satisfy these requirements.
