

Guidelines:

Preschool/Head Start: 50 minutes/week (Total 600 min.)

K-1st: 50 min./week (Total 600 min.)

2nd - 3rd: 75 min./week (Total 900 min.)

4th - 6th: 100 min./ week (Total 1200 min.)

Reading can be done any day during the week as long as
the per week minimum is achieved!

Our goal is for each child to

Read DAILY!

12 weeks of reading is the required minimum to redeem
your chart and get a prize. There is one extra week on the
chart.
