- baptism.
- No baptisms are scheduled during Lent.
- At least one godparent must be Catholic.
- If a proxy represents a godparent, the proxy must be Catholic.
- If both godparents are represented by proxies, both proxies must be Catholic.
- Catholic godparents who are not members of St. John Church must provide a letter of good standing from their parish. This letter must be received at least two weeks prior to the baptism or the baptism may need to be rescheduled.

## **Note on Selecting Godparents**

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that godparents must be "firm believers," able and ready to help the newly baptized... on the road to Christian life" (CCC 1255). They must live a life of faith consistent with their role and "seriously assume" responsibility for the baptized person's spiritual growth.

The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith has stated:

- If it is not possible to find a suitable godparent, baptism may be conferred without one.
- It is **not permissible** to allow an openly transsexual person to serve as a godparent.
