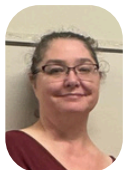

It is a significant process of restructuring to maximize our existing pastoral leadership and provide a sustainable structure for the future. It will allow us to keep our parishes and schools vibrant and mission-focused.

The fruit of this discernment will be the **One Parish Plan**, which will be submitted to the Archbishop as part of forming the new unified parish.

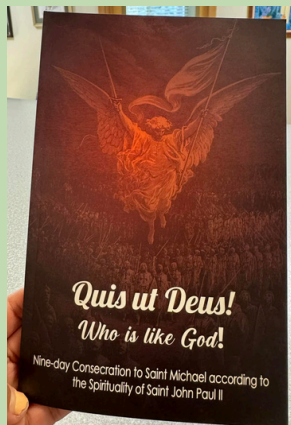



## READINGS FOR SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 8 - Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

### First Reading

Isaiah 58:7-10

*When your fasting feeds the hungry, a new day dawns.*

### Psalm

Psalm 112

*"The just man is a light in darkness to the upright."*

### Second Reading

1 Corinthians 2:1-5

*Paul's message doesn't rest on his own wisdom but on the power of the Spirit.*

### Gospel

Matthew 5:13-16

*You are the salt of the earth and the light of the world.*

Light binds together today's scripture readings. Isaiah preaches that when we share what we have with those in need, light will drive out the dark. In the psalm we sing that the one who acts with justice is a light in the darkness. Paul tells the Corinthians that the power of the Holy Spirit has enlightened their faith. In the Gospel, Jesus instructs his disciples to let their light shine, so the world can see the good that they do. As we listen to the words of scripture, let us appreciate the metaphor of light in expressing what God asks us to do.

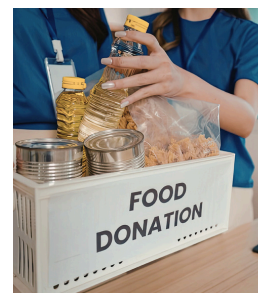
### St. Francis of Assisi Ministry

# FAITH IN FOCUS



## Dance



**“Let them praise [God’s] name in dance” (Psalm 149:3).**

**“Praise [the Lord] with tambourines and dance” (Psalm 150:4).**

**“And all shall sing in their festive dance” (Psalm 87:7).**

**“David and all Israel danced before God with great enthusiasm, amid songs and music” (1 Chronicles 13:8).**

**“Then young women shall make merry and dance. . . . I will turn their mourning into joy” (Jeremiah 31:13).**

FROM ANCIENT times, faithful people have praised God with dance. Prayer may involve the sound of the singing voice or the silence of a fixed gaze. The body may participate with folded hands and bowed heads, or in the more complex ways of dance. St. Teresa of Avila, St. Philip Neri, and St. Gerald Majella are among those who incorporated dance in their prayer. Even today, dance is one way that some people lift their minds and hearts to God in the unity of the Holy Spirit.

Liturgical dance has never been an official part of the universal Roman liturgy. But there are plenty of examples of sung and instrumental music, vocal and silent prayer. Still, some Catholics have danced to express their religious sentiments before God. In 1975, the Vatican said dance “cannot be introduced into liturgical celebrations” in the West, because it relates to the “profaneness” of Western culture (Notitiae 11, CDWDS). However, dance has continued in some liturgical celebrations throughout the world, even at Masses with the pope.

Because dance is still unusual in liturgical prayer, many Catholics sense discomfort when it is presented. But those who dance usually do so because of their faith, in hopes of lifting the thoughts of others up from malice and toward prayer.

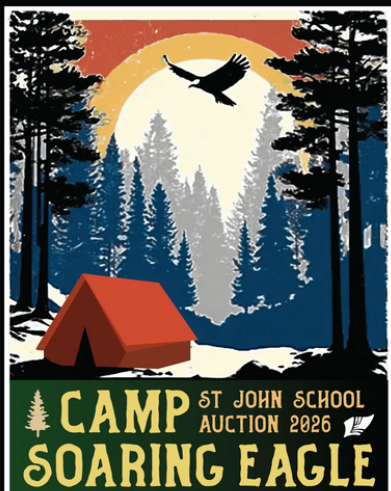

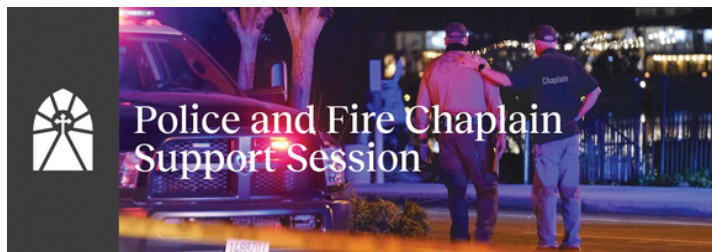

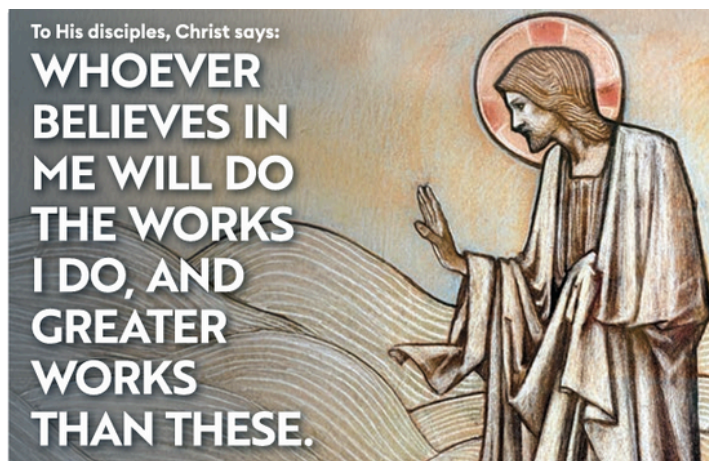
