



## Parents Code of Conduct

- Parents agree to support the Club in requiring players to abide by and adhere to the *CVFC Players Code of Conduct*.
- Parents agree to provide transportation to/from their child's practices and games.
- Parents agree to arrive on time to practices and games.
- Parents will refrain from verbal abuse of players, coaches, referees, opponents, and spectators. Let the referees do their job. Do not make comments to the referees, yell at the referees or otherwise antagonize them in any way.
- Parents will not coach from the sidelines during games. Please limit your comments to positive encouragement. Please allow your child and his/her teammates to problem solve individually and/or collectively while using their skills to find solutions and play the game.
- Parents will allow the coach to manage and facilitate all of the training sessions. Parents will remain outside of the playing area during practices and training sessions.
- Parents will agree to pay for any property damages that can be attributed to their child.
- Parents will observe the mandatory 24-hour "cooling off" period with issues related to the coach and/or his/her decisions. If the issue cannot be resolved following a mandatory 24-hour cooling off period and discussion with the coach, the Club Director of Coaching will intervene.
- Parents may also direct concerns in writing or by electronic means to the Club's Executive Board.
- Parents must understand that coaches, managers, and directors are dedicated to quality soccer and will conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the Club's policies and objectives.
- Parents will strive to express interest, encouragement, and support to their child.
- Parents will remember to allow their child to "own" their experience, not relive theirs through their child's experience.
- Parents will remember that their child is a "human being" not a "human doing" and they will be stressed out when you demand performance over approval.
- Carpooling Protocol: Do not be the only adult driving someone else's child in your car. Make sure there is another person with you and keep your child with you.
- Traveling Protocol: No adult may share a room alone with a player they are not related to. There are to be no unsupervised minors in hotel rooms; players are always chaperoned.
