

Looking ahead to our 2026-2027 program year, I am already aware of positions we will need filled. Please consider reaching out to now, so we can get you properly trained for whatever role you would like to serve in.

For the Good News Center: To have it so our catechists returning next year only teach one class, we need 8 catechists. Each grade meets once a week for one hour. Responsibilities of the catechists are to prepare lessons, bulletin boards, walk students to & from the school, and have a heart for Jesus.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: If all goes as planned, we will be launching our Level III Atrium in the fall. We are at a critical stage in our CGS program, we need people willing to go through the training to be a Level I and then Level II trainings. 8th-12th grade small group leaders: We are looking to start 1-2 boy and 1-2 girl groups next year for our 8th & 9th grade students. Plus, we are always looking for more high school group leaders. How it works is two adults lead a group until they graduate and then start a new group. This is a rapidly growing way to approach youth ministry across the country and having huge success forming disciples for Christ. Now is time to get involved and learn the approach with our groups in session.

Another Youth Ministry item is someone to help me, Kelly, with creating service opportunities for our youth of all ages and chaperone events. Currently, what we can offer is restricted by my schedule.

Vacation Bible School: We are always blessed to find volunteers with many tasks, but one thing we are running short on is steering committee members. We meet once a month starting in February, typically on a Tuesday evening from 7-8:30PM. We talk through ideas and then break off into small groups to take care of the more specific tasks.

Adult Programs: Small group leaders, ministry members, Bible Study leaders, a prayer team, and a Women's Group to pair with our men's group.

Coffee Time: My dream has been to create space in our Good News Center for one morning a week for those dropping their kids off to school to stop, come together for time to pray, receive a small devotional time, but to also gather with others of faith to be an encouragement to each other.
