During this Easter season when we celebrate renewal and new life, I would like to encourage you to generously support the 2026 Annual Catholic Appeal. The ministries that the appeal supports brings renewal, light and hope to so many. Each of us has an important role to play building up the body of Christ, not only in our local parishes but also throughout the Archdiocese.

The Annual Catholic Appeal supports ministries we need to do as larger church in Western Washington but cannot support on our own. It enables us to engage with our youth and young adults through campus ministry, CYO programs and ministerial training programs. It funds the recruiting and training of future priests, deacons, and lay ministers. It helps to provide care for our brothers and sisters in our local hospitals and prisons. In addition to providing for more than 60 ministries throughout Western Washington, your Annual Catholic Appeal donation also funds shared services that we depend upon as a parish. We rely on many centralized services the Archdiocese provides, so that we can continue to focus on our pastoral work here at the parish.

Each of our parishes has a goal from the Archdiocese based on our size and income. The money we raise above our goal will come back to each of our churches to support a parish project. At St Jude, it is the recarpeting of the parish classrooms. At Holy Innocents, it is a new portable sound system for the Hall and outdoor events. For St Anthony, it is for church maintenance needs. The Appeal is a wonderful way to support the work of our Archdiocese and our parishes. If you gave to the appeal last year, I thank you for your generosity and ask you to consider taking a step in your giving by increasing your gift 5% this year. POPE LEO'S HOMILY IN ANCIENT HIPPO - 2ND PART

As we have just heard, the Acts of the Apostles bears witness to this by describing the lifestyle that characterizes humanity when it has been renewed by the Holy Spirit (cf. Acts 4:32-37). Even today, we must embrace this apostolic rule and put it into practice, meditating on it as an authentic criterion for ecclesial reform: a reform that must begin in the heart, if it is to be genuine, and must encompass everyone if it is to be effective.

First, "the whole group of those who believed were of one heart and soul" (v. 32). This spiritual unity is a concordia: a word that signifies well the communion of hearts that beat as one because they are united with the heart of Christ. The early Church, therefore, was not based on a social contract, but rather on the harmony of faith, affections, ideas and life decisions centered on the love of God who became man to save all the peoples of the earth.

Second, let us admire the tangible effects of the spiritual unity among "everything they owned was held in common" (v. 32). Everyone has everything, sharing in one another's goods as members of a single body. No one is deprived of anything, because everyone shares what they have. Since possession can be transformed into gift, this fraternal dedication does not represent a utopia. Only hearts divided against one another and souls consumed by greed believe that it is. On the contrary, faith in the one God, Lord of heaven and earth, unites people according to perfect justice, which calls everyone to charity — that is, to love every creature with the love that God gives us in Christ. Therefore, in the face of poverty and oppression, the guiding principle above all for Christians is charity: let us do to those around us, as we would have them do to us (cf. Mt 7:12). Inspired by this law, inscribed in our hearts by God, the Church is continually reborn, for where there is despair she kindles hope, where there is misery she brings dignity, and where there is conflict she brings reconciliation.

Third, the passage from Acts shows us the foundation of this new life, which embraces peoples of every language and culture: "With great power the apostles gave their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all" (v. 33). The charity that motivates them is more than a moral commitment; it is a sign of salvation: the Apostles proclaim that our lives can change because Christ has risen from the dead. The primary task of pastors as ministers of the Gospel is therefore to bear witness to God before the world with one heart and one soul, not permitting our concerns to lead us astray through fear, nor trends to undermine us through compromise. Dearest Christians of Algeria, you remain a humble and faithful sign of Christ's love in this land. Bear witness to the Gospel through simple gestures, genuine relationships and a dialogue lived out day by day: in this way, you bring flavor and light to the places where you live. Your presence in this country is like incense: a glowing grain that spreads fragrance because it gives glory to the Lord and joy and comfort to so many brothers and sisters....POPE LEO

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER ACTS 8:5-8, 14-17; PS66:1-7, 16, 20; 1 PT 3:15-18; JN 14:15-21

Our readings remind us of both the importance of the Holy Spirit in our lives and the truth that love of God is shown through concrete actions — this is precisely why the stewardship way of life is so necessary. In our first reading from Acts, we hear that the Samaritans had accepted the word of God, yet something was still missing. Peter and John came to them and prayed that they might receive the Holy Spirit, “for it had not yet fallen upon any of them.” Only after they laid hands on them did they receive the fullness of what God desired to give. We, too, have received the Holy Spirit — first at Baptism and more fully at Confirmation. The gifts and guidance of the Holy Spirit are essential for living the stewardship way of life.

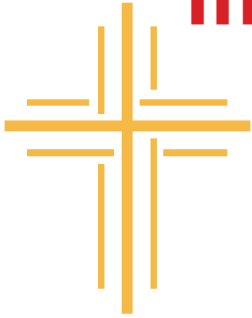
As we draw closer to Pentecost, this is a fitting time to examine our relationship with the Holy Spirit. Do we rely on Him? Do we turn to Him for strength, wisdom, and direction in our daily lives? Our second reading reinforces this call. “Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts.” Christ must be more than a part of our lives — He must be at the center of them. As His disciples, we are called to surrender every aspect of our lives to Him — our time, our talent, and our treasure.

The stewardship way of life gives us a concrete way to live this out. It allows us to “prove” our love, in a sense, because love is not merely sentiment. “Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me,” Jesus tells us.

True love requires courage, humility, and trust. It requires that we lean on the Holy Spirit to help us make Christ the Lord of our lives each day. But the reward is beyond anything this world can offer. “Whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and reveal myself to him.” Let us ask the Holy Spirit to help us fully embrace the stewardship way of life, so that we may truly sanctify Christ as Lord in our hearts.

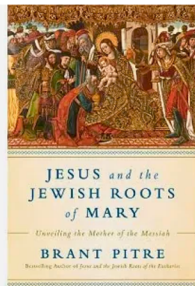
