These prices are effective as of August 25, 2025 but thereafter subject to change without notice.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers, official death certificates, church/clergy, organists, musicians or singers, or monument inscriptions.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR,

This is a non declinable charge applied to any type of funeral selected. It is for the staff to respond to initial requests for services and arrangement conference with a responsible party to determine the type of services needed. Also included in this charge is obtaining Nurse Pronouncement and/or Certificate of Death from medical facility and doctor's offices, completion of legal requirements to secure and obtain all necessary permits and authorizations, overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utilities, administrative and secretarial, and equipment and inventory expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains).

EMBALMING OF REMAINS.....\$ 1095.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as funeral with visitation or viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Our policy is one of common sense and sanitation. We wish to assure the safety and comfort of the families who use our funeral home. We feel the only proper way to do this is by embalming the deceased if there is a ceremony with the body present, whether the casket is open or closed. If there are religious or moral beliefs against this policy, we will honor those wishes.

REFRIGERATION (per day)\$ 85.00 It is the policy of our firm to require refrigeration of un-embalmed remains after 12 hours, this charge is per day after the initial 12 hours.
