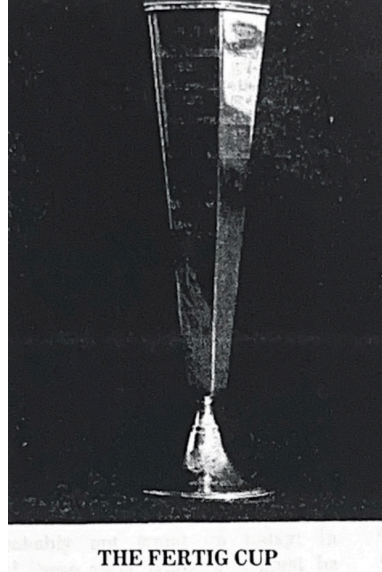

THE FERTIG CUP

1943 WINNER ELBA BRANIGIN JR SCORE 78. Elba, or Babe as most people called him, was the son of Elba Branigin Sr, Attorney and county historian and the brother of the Hon Roger Branigin former Governor of the State of Indiana! Babe was a pretty fair golfer and had a very methodical approach to the game.

The Lost Legacy of the Fertig Cup

The Fertig Cup was donated in 1929 by Dayton Fertig, president of Hillview Country Club from 1928-1930 and a key figure in its early success. Remarkably, it was one of only two trophies to survive the fire that once destroyed the Club. The cup served as a traveling prize, awarded each July 4th to the winner of the Club's annual tournament. Each champion engraved their name on the cup before passing it on to the following year's victor, continuing a tradition that lasted until 1950. After that, the trophy was no longer awarded, and over time, its existence faded from memory.

Fun Fact: Among the winners of the Fertig Cup was Elba Branigin Jr., known as "Babe," an esteemed lawyer and brother of Roger Branigin, Indiana's 42nd governor.

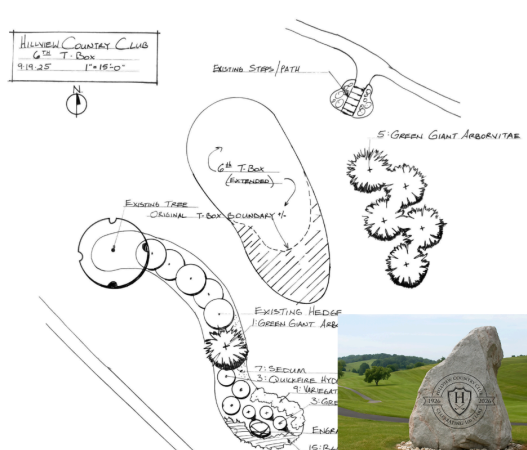


History Wall
