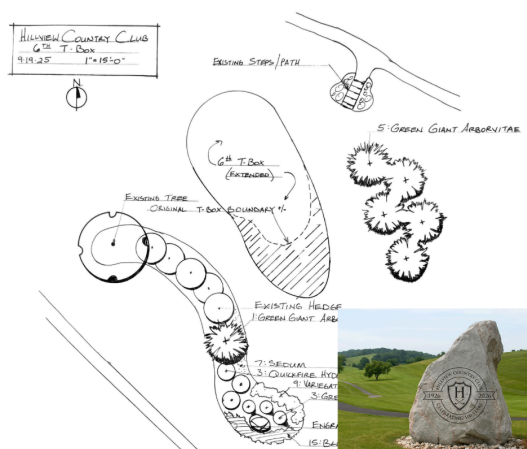


History Wall
