### Centennial Dedication Opportunities



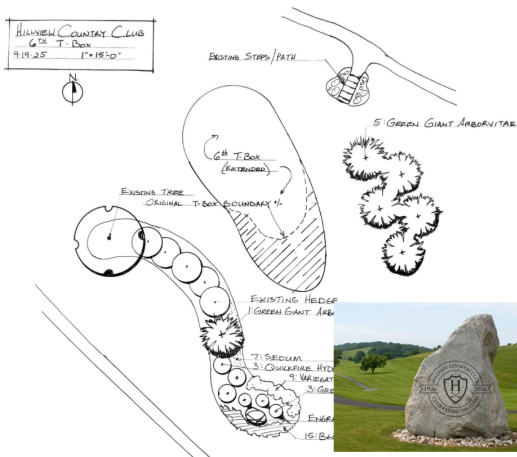
#### History Wall
