The Modernized Clubhouse

Between 2012 and 2015, the Clubhouse underwent a series of renovations that enhanced both its appearance and functionality. The main Clubhouse was remodeled, with the addition of porches, updated windows, and improved gathering spaces such as the fire pit at Lou's Den. Beyond the main building, the Club also saw improvements across the grounds, including a new entrance and tee box on Hole 11, cart path repairs, and updated locker room facilities. Together, these enhancements helped create the modern Club experience that members enjoy today.

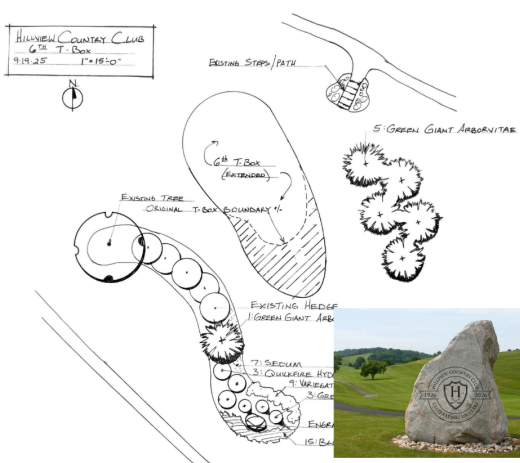


History Wall

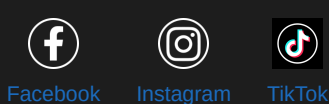
