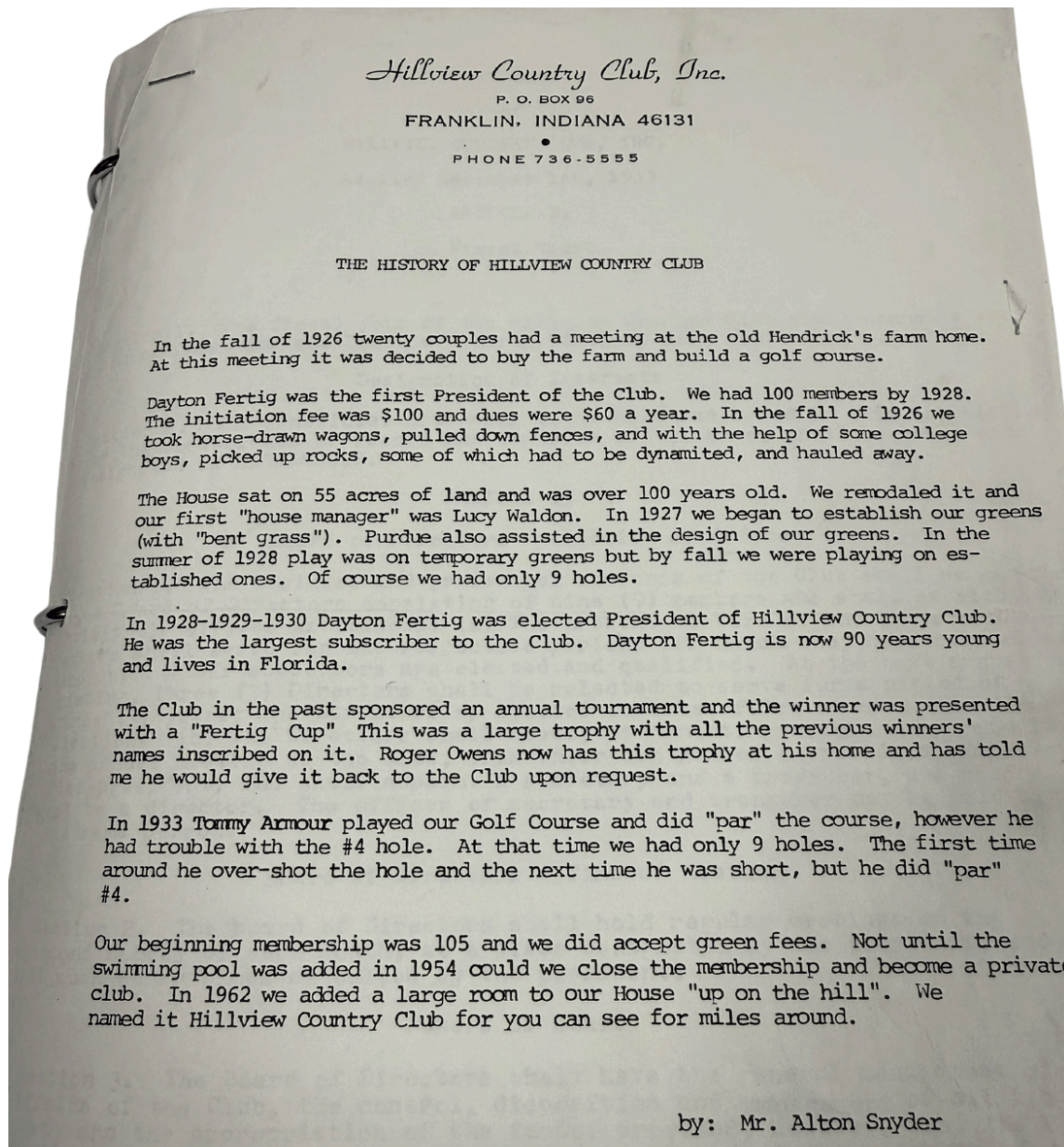




### The Clubhouse Chronicles



#### Tommy Armour

Tommy Armour, a Scottish golfer, is best known for his wins in the 1927 U.S. Open and the 1931 British Open. A well-known golfer, Armour visited Hillview Country Club in 1933 and played the course.

Reports by Mr. Alton Snyder, a past president and member of Hillview, note that Armour did par the course, but struggled on hole #4. At the time, Hillview only had 9 holes.

**Fun Fact:** The first time Armour played hole #4, he overshot it. The second time around, he was short. This being said, he was still able to par the hole!

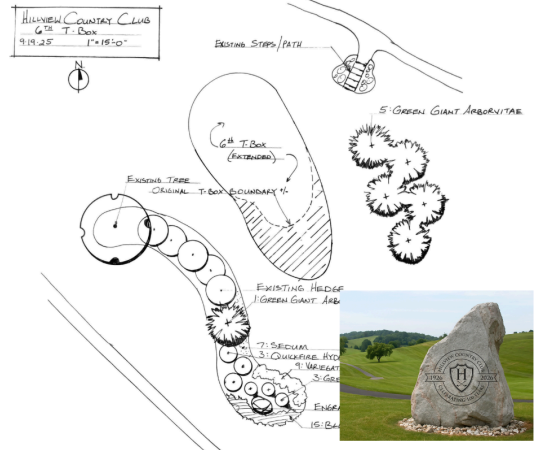
History Wall

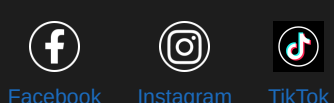
