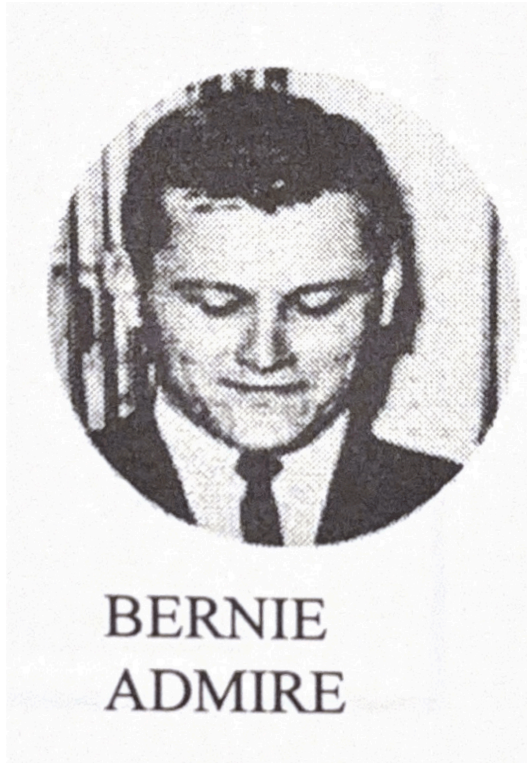




The Clubhouse Chronicles



The Legacy of Bernie Admire

Bernie was a well-liked and respected member of Hillview Country Club for over 50 years, having joined the Club in 1961. He was very involved in Club business and was a member of the Board when the course grew from 9 holes to 18 in the late 1960's. His home videos showing the construction of the back 9 was an obvious testament of Bernie's pride in the Club. He served as President of the Club in 1970, with his term ending just days before a fire destroyed the original Clubhouse on the hill.

Bernie played in many Hillview events throughout the years, including the Pete Lagle Memorial Tournament, Club Championships, Saturday Morning Choose-ups and Father/Son golf tournaments. He enjoyed the competition, but more importantly, enjoyed getting to know others on the golf course and establishing life-long friendships. As he got older, though he began to lose distance and his swing endured the shakes, he remained a wizard around the greens, boasting a handicap in single digits. He recorded two (2) holes-in-one, the first coming on Father's Day 1983, as he hit an 8 iron into the cup on the 14th hole and the second coming a few years later on the 10th hole just after his version of a Babe Ruth point in that direction.

His family fondly remembers the tales Bernie would spin of his golfing trips with his buddies, but one of the more memorable stories involved Bernie leaving a note one morning for his wife saying that he was going to Sarah Shank, which caused quite the uproar with the unsuspecting young wife (Emma "Sug" Admire) who thought he was going to see a lady, not play a golf course.

Those who knew Bernie would all agree that he was a devoted family man. Both Bernie and Sug passed away in June 2013. He and Sug had been married for over 53 years and they left behind 4 sons (and 4 daughters), 10 grandchildren and now several great grandchildren.

Fun Fact: Bernie was known to some as the "Sweet Swinger from South of Samaria"!

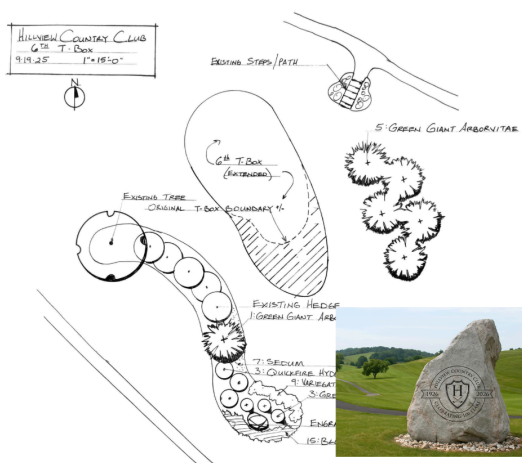


History Wall
