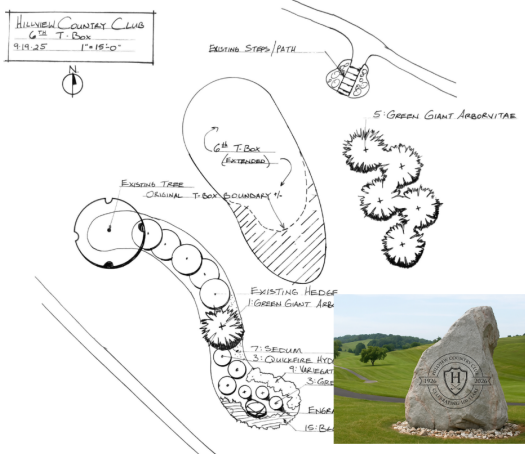


History Wall
