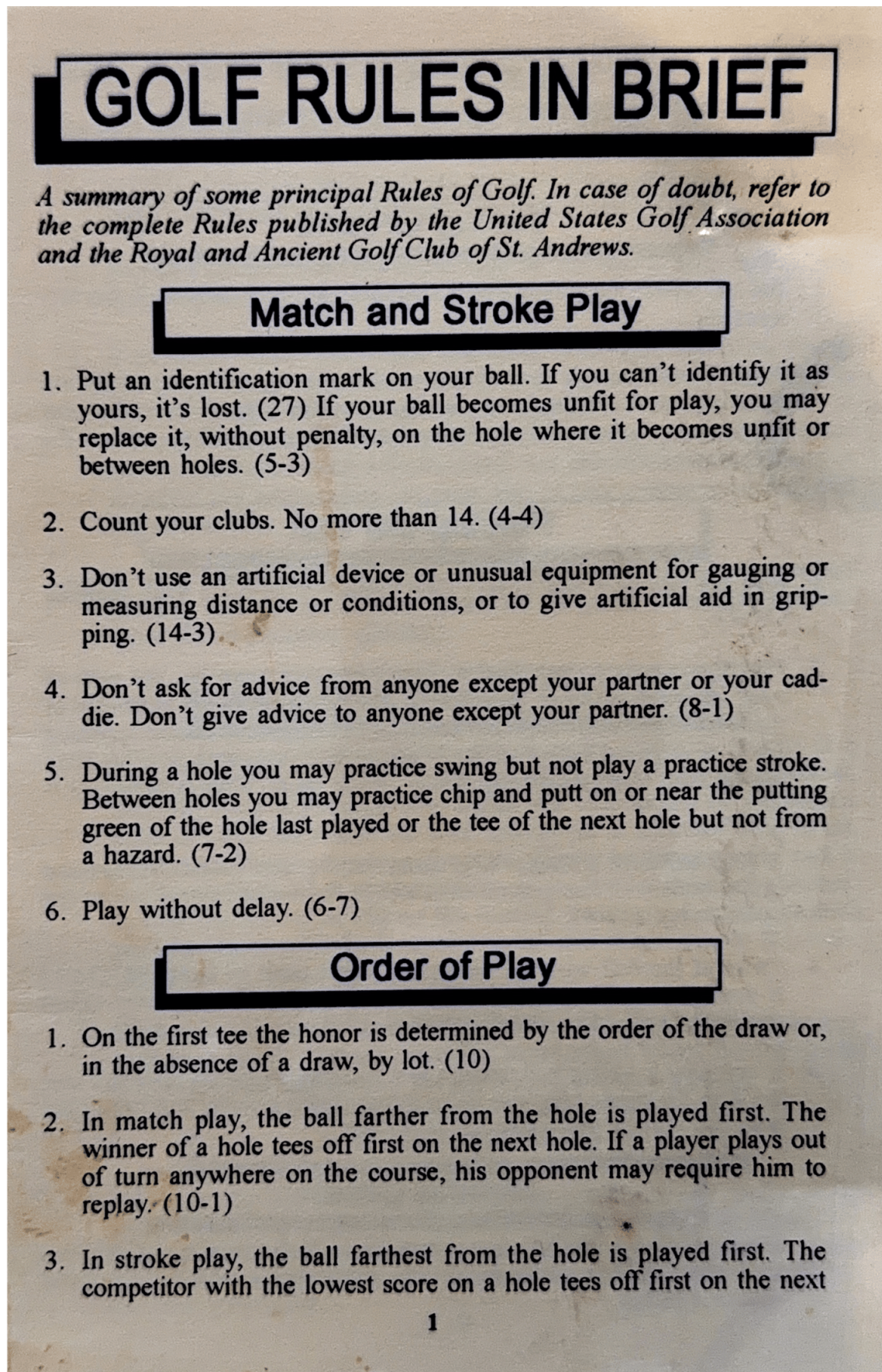

Rules of Play

Golf etiquette has always been an important part of the Hillview Country Club experience, but the Club's "Rules of Play" have evolved to reflect the modern game. Players are expected to complete nine holes in two hours or less (18 holes in 4 hours or less) and practice is limited to designated practice areas rather than on course greens. The current rules also include procedures for weather delays, requiring players to leave the course after an air horn signals approaching lightning, and emphasize the importance of posting attested scores to maintain an accurate handicap. While the game has changed over the years, Hillview's commitment to courteous play, safety, and respect for fellow golfers has remained a tradition since the Club's founding in 1926.

Fun Fact: Handicap scores from any IGA golf course, even out-of-state rounds, can count toward your handicap, as long as they are properly signed and attested!

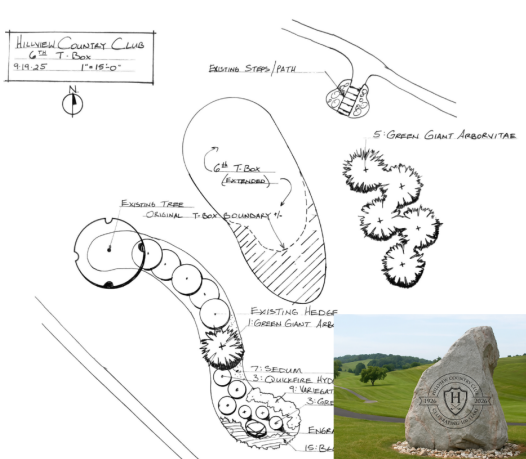


History Wall
