Centennial Dedication Opportunities

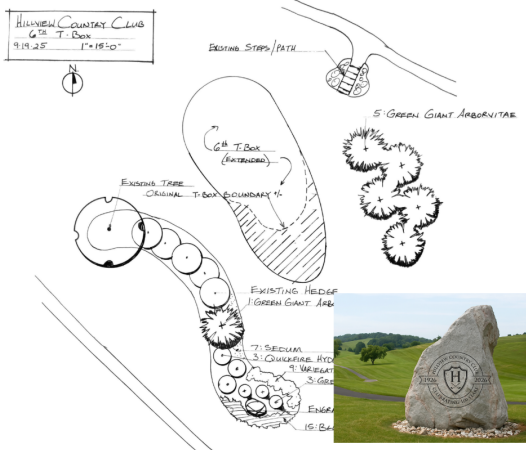


History Wall
