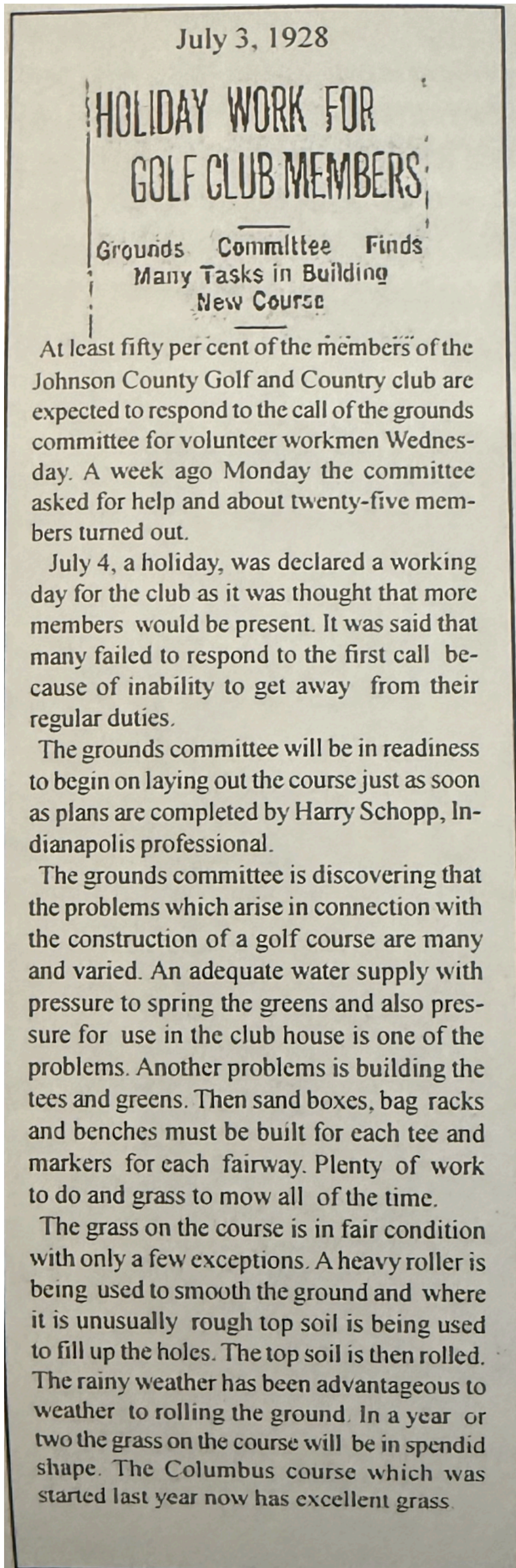




## The Clubhouse Chronicles



### Clearing of the Land

On Saturday, June 23rd, 1928, *The Franklin Evening Star* reported that the Franklin Golf Club's grounds committee had invited members to attend a clean-up day on the club grounds. Following this clean-up day, there was an additional clean-up day on July 4th, 1928. These clean-ups focused on gathering rocks and trash from the grounds. After completing these clean-up days, the grounds committee prepared to lay out the course. Harry Schopp, an Indianapolis architect, finalized these plans.

**Fun Fact:** Harry Schopp, the architect of the Franklin Golf Club, was also the architect of the Tippecanoe Lake Country Club and South Grove Golf Course!

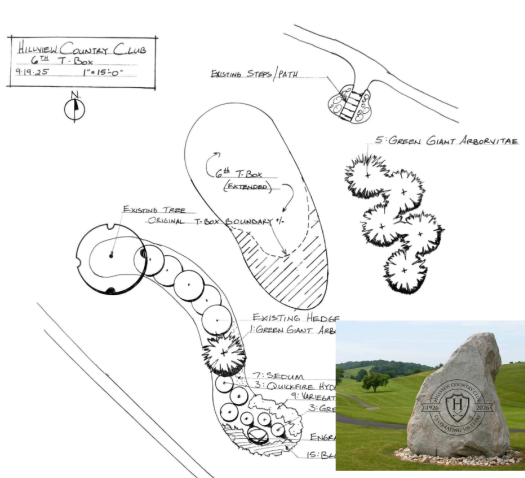
**First wave pre-orders are due by March 1st.**
