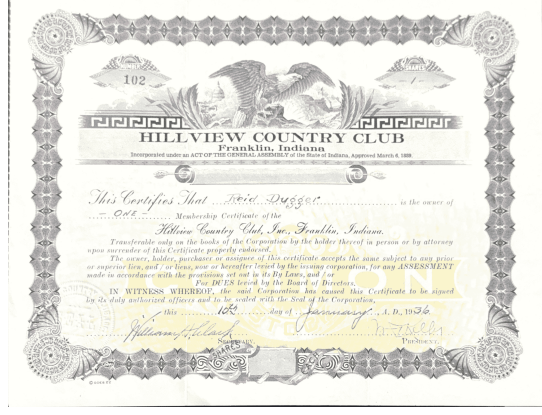

See the official membership certificate of Mr. Reid Dugger, signed January 10th, 1936.

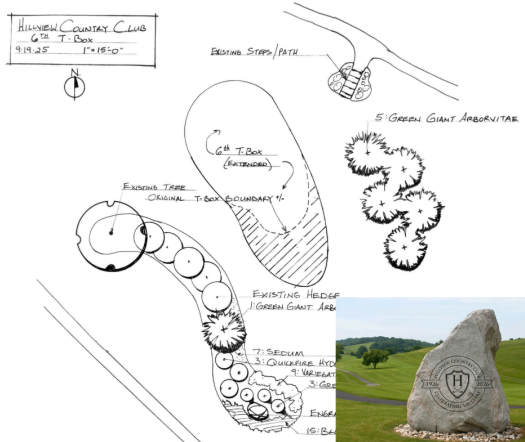
Centennial Dedication Opportunities
