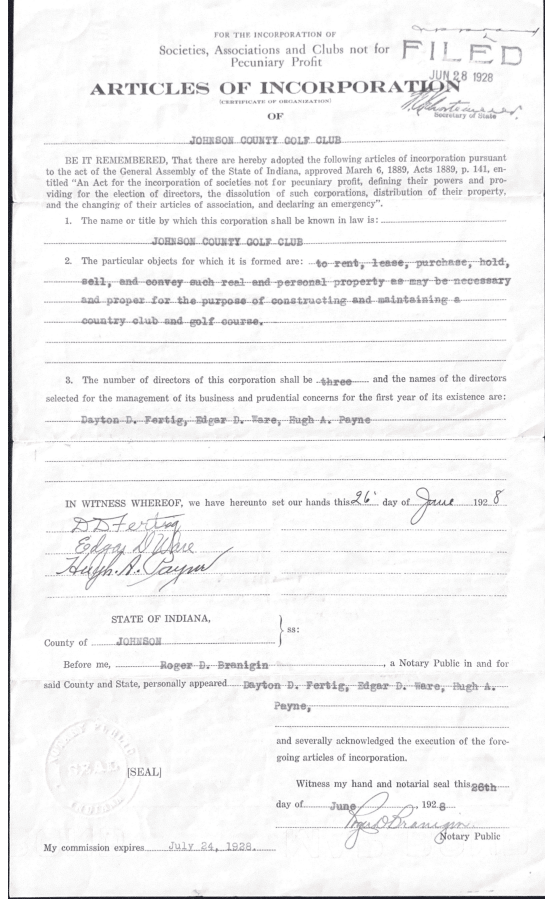




### The Clubhouse Chronicles



#### Purchase of the Land and Articles of Incorporation

In 1917, Lewis Hendricks' house and the surrounding 54 acres were put up for auction. The land was purchased by Charles Hougham for \$3,000. Following the purchase of the land, 20 couples met in the house and formed the club, and began construction on the greens.

On June 26, 1928, Indiana's official state records show that the Johnson County Golf Club became a corporation. The Articles of Incorporation were filed with F.E. Schortemeir, then-Secretary of State of Indiana. They were notarized by Roger E. Branigin, a then-Notary Public for the County and State.

**Fun Fact:** Recognize the notary's last name? Roger D. Branigin, then-Notary Public for the County and State, precedes a rich family history of local involvement. Roger D. Branigin was the 42nd Governor of Indiana. Additionally, Roger D. Branigin graduated from Franklin's beloved Franklin College!

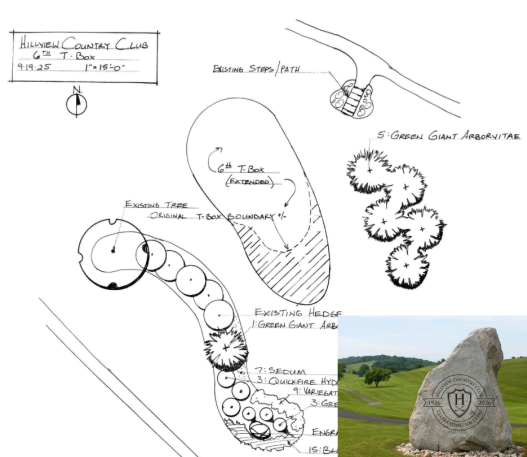
