The Cypress Heart

Are You Ever Surprised?

When you make reading The Word of God a priority each day, are you ever surprised what you find? We know that the Holy Spirit speaks to our spirit in keeping with the Word of God (or it's not Him). Today's sermon will be one of those discoveries that The Lord gave me for us today. Grab a piece of paper and write John the Baptist in the middle. Draw a line above his name. Now grab your Bible and read what Jesus said about John the Baptist in Matthew 11:7-11. In verse 11 Jesus says, "Truly I say to you, among those born of women there has not arisen anyone greater than he". On your list you can now write all of the Old Testament names under John the Baptist like Moses, Elijah, Elisha, David, Solomon, Jeremiah, Daniel, you can write them all. But Jesus said that John is on top. Now write above the line the phrase from verse 11 "Yet the one who is the least in the kingdom of Heaven is greater than he." That means if you have been saved, God transferred you from the kingdom of darkness into His glorious kingdom of light. That means that even if you are the least in the kingdom of God your name is above John the Baptist and all of the other names below his. I will let that sink in for a minute. (contemplate the implications of who you are because of Jesus right now). Okay, that is not a matter of pride for us but if people tell you that you cannot hear from God like those people in the Old Testament, tell me why God would close communication from His Spirit to yours based on your position in Christ? You are a part of His Church. You are a part of the Bride of Christ. When you are convicted by the Holy Spirit because of sin, you are hearing from God. If what you think you are hearing from God doesn't match the Bible, you are hearing from the wrong spirit. The Apostle John described that situation in 1 John 4:1-6. If we can hear from the spirits that belong to Satan (verse 3) then why in the world would we not be able to hear from the Holy Spirit in keeping with The Word?

God's purpose for the Little Cypress Baptist Church is to obey the Great Commission by being involved here and abroad in evangelism through missions, discipling believers, meeting social needs, and providing opportunities for Christian worship.
