**The Cypress Heart****Celebrating The Incarnation**

Jesus is the gift of the bread of heaven. Just like God sent manna to the nation of Israel in the wilderness, is the one who came from Heaven to give life. When Jesus says in John 6:63 that the flesh profits nothing, it was to say that the physical realities was not the point. Spiritually speaking, our coming to Jesus and belief in Him would result in our salvation. That is what it means when we receive Him. The error of interpretation that eating communion would be eating His body and drinking His blood, then anyone could eat communion and be saved whether they believed or not. Besides, Jesus had not even established the remembrance that we call the Lord's Supper at this point. In addition, the view that the bread and cup are mystically changed into the blood and the body and blood of Jesus would be a violation of the Law. No one was supposed to eat meat with blood in it or consume blood according to Deuteronomy 12:16 and Leviticus 17:10-14. So, why was the body of Jesus important to the process of redemption? "First, Christ said, "You did not want animal sacrifices or sin offerings or burnt offerings or other offerings for sin, nor were you pleased with them" (though they are required by the law of Moses). Then he said, "Look, I have come to do your will." He cancels the first covenant in order to put the second into effect. For God's will was for us to be made holy by the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ, once for all time." (Hebrews 10:8-10, NLT) The Apostle John received this message from God: "So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son." "From his abundance we have all received one gracious blessing after another. For the law was given through Moses, but God's unfailing love and faithfulness came through Jesus Christ." (John 1:14,16-17, NLT)
