The Promise Fulfilled

“Therefore, the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel.” (Isaiah 7:14, NASB95) as well as Isaiah 9:1-7 are prophecies that were fulfilled and will be fulfilled. Liz and I were enjoying the Worship Initiative daily devotion created by Shane and Shane this past Monday. The devotion reflected on the connection between these passages from Isaiah and the fulfillment of Revelation chapters 21 and 22. The passage above was used in a message from an angel who was telling Joseph to take Mary as his wife (Matt. 1:23). The angel does some translation work when he tells Joseph that the name Immanuel means ‘God with us. It was fulfilled the first time when Jesus was born-the first Advent. It will be fulfilled eternally when Jesus returns to the earth in His second coming, the second advent. After reigning on the earth for a thousand years with His Bride, the church, He will bring final judgment to all things. He will replace the current heavens and earth with the eternal New Heaven and Earth. In Revelation 21:1-4 we see redemptive work of God completed through His Son Jesus, “Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, “Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away.”” (Revelation 21:1–4, NASB95) People will ultimately find that the secular Christmas is not able to provide real hope, peace or joy- only Jesus can do that through The Incarnation.
