The Cypress Heart

Disciples of Jesus, Baptists, Congregational...

Little Cypress Baptist Church has, from its beginning, had the revelation of God in His Word for the foundation of their beliefs. To know God how He has been revealed and to obey Him is how we function. As a church body, we search the scripture and find that our biblical beliefs are most clearly seen in the Baptist teaching of scripture. There are no works for a person to do to be saved is uniquely true of the Christian faith and of the Baptist understanding of scripture. The Book of Acts shows the early church engaged in Worship, Fellowship, Prayer, Ministry, Discipleship, and Mission which is Outreach/Evangelism. The Head of the church is Jesus Christ. So, Baptists do not have any other 'leader at the top.' There is no pope for example. In a sudden internal crisis in the early church, the apostles called on the church to select men to do a particular service to resolve the problem. This is referred to by some biblical scholars as proto deacons. The apostles did not make the decision; the congregation did. You will see it as you read Acts 6:3-6 "*Therefore, brethren, select from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task. "But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word.*" The statement found approval with the whole congregation; and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch. And these they brought before the apostles; and after praying, they laid their hands on them." (NASB95) As a result, Little Cypress Baptist Church makes its major decisions in a time of meeting that we have every other month unless a more immediate decision is needed. Every member of LCBC can hear reports from all of the ministry areas, prayerfully vote on decisions that must be made, and share ideas and concerns. We have that freedom and responsibility in the congregational model. We have that freedom as Baptists. And, by His grace, we have been called to faithfully follow Jesus as His disciples that make disciples.

God's purpose for the Little Cypress Baptist Church is to obey the Great Commission by being involved here and abroad in evangelism through missions, discipling believers, meeting social needs, and providing opportunities for Christian worship.
