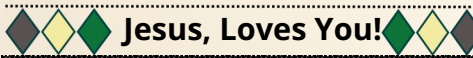

The Witnesses Begin To Take Sides

After all that Jesus had taught and done to show that He is the full representation of the Father, there is a growing group in opposition to Him. These in opposition are the religious leaders that should recognize the miracles and words of Jesus immediately. Jesus was doing the same kind of miracles that prophets had done by the power of God. If they would recognize those miracles to be valid, they should have recognized the actions and words to be valid. The problem is that the religious leaders wanted to stay the same. They wanted to be in control of what happened at their 'church.' They wanted to maintain their power. John the Baptist had recognized that he must decrease and Jesus increased. The religious leaders did not want to decrease.

Now, Jesus is going to move on to preach to the crowds and His disciples. When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead and people could talk to Lazarus about his experience, the religious leaders could see they were losing control. I wonder where Gamaliel was in these verbal attacks and assassination plans on Jesus? You may remember Gamaliel from Acts 5:33ff. when he gives counsel to the religious leaders about killing the apostles to stop the gospel. vs.38-39 *"So in the present case, I say to you, stay away from these men and let them alone, for if this plan or action is of men, it will be overthrown; but if it is of God, you will not be able to overthrow them; or else you may even be found fighting against God."* (NASB95)

God's purpose for the Little Cypress Baptist Church is to obey the Great Commission by being involved here and abroad in evangelism through missions, discipling believers, meeting social needs, and providing opportunities for Christian worship.

(1 Corinthians 11:27-32)

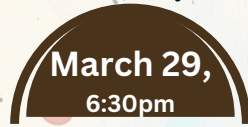
