The Cypress Heart

Jesus, His Disciples, and the Last Hours

The Gospel of John focuses a great deal of attention on the last Passover that Jesus spent with His disciples before the crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension to Heaven. In chapter 11:55 the scripture says that Passover was near. There are 21 chapters in the Gospel of John, so nearly half of it is devoted to the last days he would spend with His disciples. You know how prominent the importance of believing in Jesus has been to our series. The emphasis on a life changing belief or faith as will be emphasized as Jesus spent this deep and personal time with His committed disciples minus Judas Iscariot. Jesus was not calling His disciples to trust in things they had read or heard about Him. He was calling on them to believe, to have faith in Him as a person. You might imagine sitting in the room as He looked from person to person, older to younger, men and women and said, "Do not Let your heart be troubled; Believe in God, Believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come to receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also." Though we do not see Jesus with our eyes at this time and must walk by faith and not sight, the day will come when He will return for all who truly believe. Meanwhile, we have a remembrance He gave us. This remembrance springs from the Passover. Jesus is our Passover Lamb; perfect, without flaw or blemish, the sacrifice for our sin.

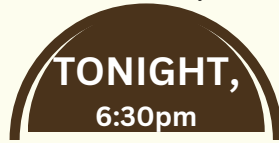
