Picking Up Where We Left Off on Putting Together the Pieces

We know that those who read and hear the book of Revelation are blessed. We can say, without a doubt, that the Lord will bless us for these messages. For many, the book is a lot of bad news. Even for the who are saved during the tribulation, it sounds like bad news because of persecution and martyrdom. What we should be hearing is God saying to the people in the world, "Here's one more chance, here's one more chance," again and again. We will hear the Word of God giving all of these chances to be saved, showing the truth that God does not wish that any would perish, but that all would come to repentance. That is the heart of God though He knows by foreknowledge that most will not come. Our choices matter. We are not riding through life with God giving us just the illusion of making choices. He is so very sovereign that we make real choices with real consequences, but He sets the boundaries and consequences. David Jeremiah often reminds people that from the moment the Great Tribulation begins, the Millennial Reign of Christ is only seven years away!
