Putting The Events in Order

In chapter four we joined the Apostle John in the Throne room in Heaven. The Lamb that was slain (Jesus) is the only one found worthy to break the seals on the scroll which is the title deed to the earth. As The Lamb breaks seals one through four, we see the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse take their turn bringing first the Conqueror, then War, followed by Famine and last of all Death. A fourth of the total world population is destroyed at this point. In verse 17 of chapter 6 we see that the great day of God's wrath has come. This no 24 hour day. According to Jesus in Matthew 24:21 this is a period of history unlike has ever happened or ever will happen again. But remember that our God doesn't want people to perish, so He selects and sends out 144 thousand male, virgin men (Rev. 14:4) to preach the gospel. Most of chapter 7 is an interlude to allow us to catch up with what is going on in Heaven, but chapter 8 brings on the 7th seal which is how God unseals the 7 Trumpet judgments including their Three Woes. Soon the Apostle John will receive some specific information about the major characters on earth and will be given a backstory from eternity past to share with us.
