CHRISTIE'S CAROUSEL OF LEARNING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1) What age must the children be to attend school?

a. They must be 2-9 years of age for the Summer and 2-5 years of age for the Fall Programs.

2) Do the children need to be potty trained?

a. No. Contact us for details about our potty-training program.

3) Do the children need to attend the same days each week in the summer and fall school year?

- a. No, in the summer your days and times may vary each week or remain the same.
- b. Yes, in the fall school year, they must stay consistent with the 2, 3, 4, or 5 days you choose when registering. All times must be the same for all the days registered.

4) When can I come to visit your school?

a. To schedule an in-person tour, please call 847-825-4568.

5) Do you have availability now?

a. All availability is offered on a first come, first serve basis. Please call 847-825-4568 or email info@christiescarousel.com to find the exact days and times that are available.

6) How do I register for the upcoming Summer Program and/or Fall Program?

- a. You may register for the Summer and Fall Programs at the same time or Summer only or fall only at our Open registration. Our procedure for registration is as follows:
 - i. The families currently enrolled register first.
 - ii. We then open registration to the public on a first come, first serve basis according to availability.
 - iii. Enclosed are details on how to register your child for our Summer and/or Fall Programs.

7) What do you teach children daily?

a. Our curriculum goals and daily schedule are enclosed.

8) What are the class sizes?

a. The teacher/child ratio according to DCFS are: one teacher with eight twoyear-olds, one teacher with ten three/four/five/six-year-olds and one teacher with fifteen children enrolled in kindergarten or primary grades.

9) Are you Licensed?

a. Yes, we are licensed by the Department of Children and Family Services and must follow the state guidelines which are kept on file at our school. Also refer to the Summary of Licensing Standards for Day Care Centers available at the school.

2026 Summer Camp Registration, Payment, and Procedure Information

- Summer Camp is for children ages 2–9 years old.
- The Summer Program runs from **June 8, 2026, through August 7, 2026,** and consists of **9 weeks**.
- Families may enroll for any combination of weeks, including all 9 weeks.
- Days and times may vary from week to week.
- For each individual week, selected times must remain the same for the entire week.
 Scheduling & Enrollment Policies
- Once a child is registered for a specific week, days, times, or weeks may not be dropped, changed, or substituted.
- Additional weeks may be added later if space is available.
- Weekly summer tuition rates are listed below.
- A 10% sibling discount is offered per child for the same or lesser schedule.
- Fees are subject to change due to rising operational costs.

REGISTRATION & TUITION POLICIES

- A **non-refundable registration fee of \$100.00 per child** is due upon confirmation and does not apply toward tuition.
- All tuition payments are **non-refundable**.
- No credits or adjustments will be made for absences due to illness, vacations, holidays, school closings, early dismissals, COVID-19 quarantines, classroom closures, or withdrawal from Christie's Carousel of Learning programs.
- School operating expenses are based on anticipated enrollment and income.

SUMMER PAYMENT INFORMATION

- Non-Currently Enrolled / New Families
 - Families enrolled in Program 1 (7:30–5:30) for four weeks or less, or enrolled in Programs 2, 3, or 4 for any number of weeks, must pay full summer tuition by March 1, 2026.
 - Families enrolled in Program 1 (7:30–5:30) for five weeks or more will pay tuition in two installments:
 - March 1, 2026
 - April 1, 2026

Currently Enrolled Families

- Families enrolled in Programs 2 (7:30–12:30), 3 (9:00–12:30), or 4 (9:00–11:30) must pay full tuition for all enrolled weeks by June 1, 2026.
- Families enrolled in Program 1 (7:30–5:30) for four weeks or less must pay full tuition by June 1, 2026.
- Families enrolled in Program 1 (7:30–5:30) for five weeks or more will be charged as follows:

Weeks 1–5: Due June 1, 2026
 Weeks 6–9: Due July 1, 2026

SUMMER REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

- A **completed and typed registration form** must be submitted via email for each child. Fillable PDFs are available on our website.
- Registration fees will **not be collected until enrollment is confirmed**.
- All billing, including registration fees, will be processed through **Brightwheel**.

CONFIRMATIONS:

- Registration confirmations will be sent via email.
- Summer confirmations and registration fee charges may occur **after Fall confirmations and registration fees are completed**.
- Failure to submit tuition by the stated due dates will result in forfeiture of all reserved spaces.
- Once summer and/or fall registration is confirmed, you are financially responsible
 for all registration fees and tuition, all of which are non-refundable. After
 confirmation is sent, no changes, deletions, drops, swaps, or schedule
 adjustments may be made, except for approved additions to your child's schedule if
 space is available.

Registration fees are non-refundable and do not apply towards tuition.


Christie's Carousel of Learning Program Curriculum

FALL 2026-2027 REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND PROCEDURE

- The Fall program is for children ages 2–5 years old.
- The school year runs from August 10, 2026, through June 4, 2027.
- Families may choose 2, 3, 4, or 5 days per week.
- Available schedules include: 7:30–5:30, 7:30–12:30, 9:00–12:30, 9:00–11:30
- Selected days and times must remain consistent throughout the school year. Additional days may be requested if space allows.
- Once enrollment is confirmed, days and times may not be dropped, changed, or swapped. Dropping scheduled days will result in forfeiture of your child's space.

FALL 2026-2027 PAYMENT INFORMATION

- Monthly tuition rates are listed on the following page and are based on 43
 instructional weeks, divided into 10 monthly payments for the 2026–2027 school
 year.
- A 10% sibling discount is offered per child for the same or lesser schedule.
- The **first tuition payment** is due **Monday, May 11, 2026**, and secures your child's space for the Fall 2026–2027 school year.
 - Payment must be received by 5:30 p.m. on that date or the space will be relinquished.
- The second payment will be charged on September 1, 2026, with the remaining eight payments charged on the first of each month thereafter.
- Tuition rates are subject to change due to rising operational costs.
- A **non-refundable registration fee of \$125.00 per child** is due upon confirmation and does not apply toward tuition.
- All tuition and registration fees are non-refundable. No credits or adjustments will be made for absences due to illness, vacations, holidays, school closings, early dismissals, COVID-19 quarantines, classroom closures, or withdrawal from Christie's Carousel of Learning programs.

FALL 2026-2027 REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

- A typed and completed Fall registration form must be emailed for each child.
- Registration fees will not be collected until enrollment is confirmed and billing is processed through Brightwheel.
- Registration confirmations will be sent via email.
- Summer confirmations and registration fees may be collected after Fall confirmations and registration fees are completed.

Failure to submit tuition by the stated due dates will result in forfeiture of all reserved spaces.
