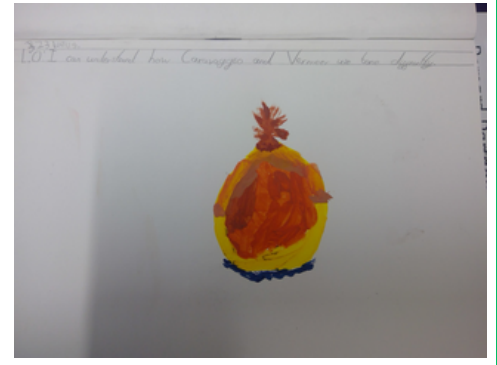
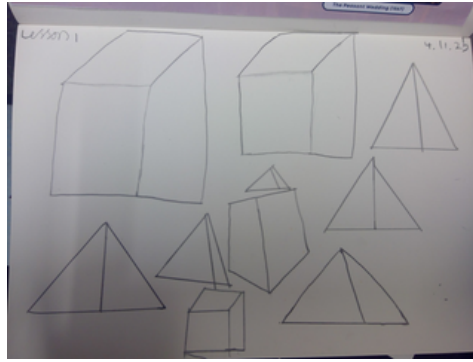

### 3/4A

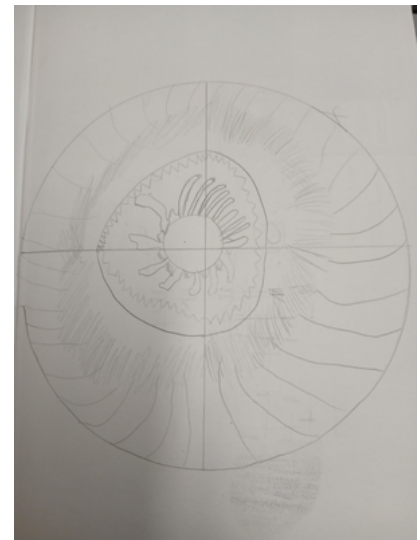


M- We were painting, we had to make new colours by mixing them.

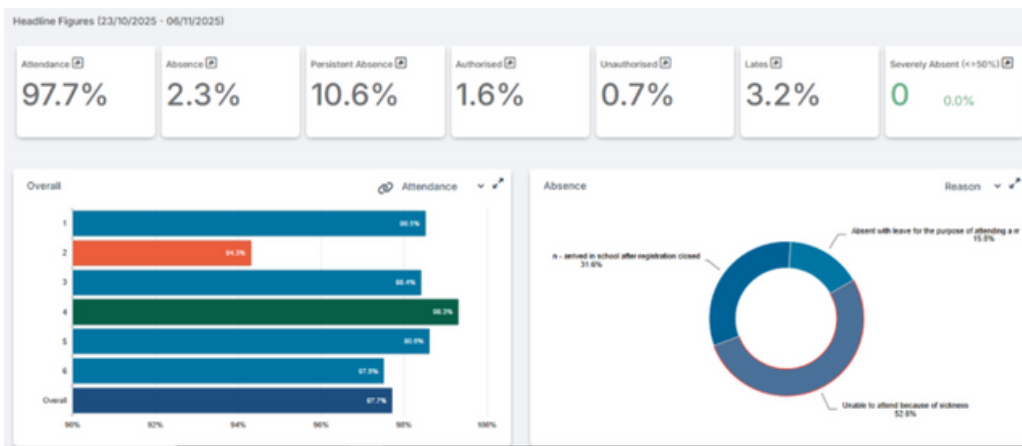
