Food

Lunch and unlimited water will be provided to each camper. Daily lunch menu is available at northalabamafca.org Campers are welcome to bring their own lunch, if desired.

Dietary Needs: Please direct food allergies and medicine to the camp trainer

All medicine should be turned into the camp nurse and placed in a ziplock bag with the camper's name on it.



Equipment

Players are required to bring their own equipment (baseball; glove & bat, fishing; fishing pole and tackle, soccer; shinguards - optional, softball; glove & bat, tennis - racquet.) If your child's sport is not listed, there is no equipment needed. Please put your child's name on <u>ALL</u> items. Each camper must provide his own shoes, socks, shorts and t-shirts.



Check-in each morning will be at Sand Mountain Park. Parents are not required to come in with your child. 8:00AM is the earliest a camper can be dropped off.



The **car pick-up sign** is included for you to visibly place in the **front window** of your vehicle as you pick up your child in the **specified car line**. The car sign or picture ID is **mandatory** for camper pick-up. Allow a **10 minute buffer** when you arrive to check your child out as it takes time to get them from their huddle. **All early check-outs must be before 2:30PM**. If you arrive after 2:30PM, we will direct you to the carline for pick-up.

- Cell phones are discouraged. If you feel your camper must have a cell phone, please advise him/her it should not be used without permission of an FCA huddle leader.
- A Registered Nurse is on duty at all times. Because of the rigorous schedule, each camper should come to camp in good physical condition. No flip flops or athletic sandals allowed.
- Due to the number of campers and planned schedules, personal camper phone calls are not allowed, except in the case of an emergency.
- In the case of an emergency, you may call the FCA Camp Office at 256-509-3692.
- Any serious violation of camp rules or regulations could result in immediate dismissal from camp.
 There will be no refund in this situation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

Camper cancellation/request for refund must be sent in writing/email in order to be valid for a refund.

There will be a \$50.00 administration fee for <u>all</u> cancellations, with the remaining balance being refunded.

BASEBALL (BOYS)

Instructors: Tyler Stovall and NE AL area middle & high school coaches

Tyler Stovall, founder of Stovall Athletics, was a three sport athlete at Hokes Bluff High School in Alabama from 2004-2008 and graduated as class Valedictorian. He represented his country by playing for Team USA in the 2007 Pan Am games (USA baseball's National team). Stovall was Louisville Slugger's national Pitcher of the Year, Gatorade Player of the Year, and Alabama's Mr. Baseball. Stovall holds 8 AHSAA records for hitting and pitching with one being a national record. Stovall led Hokes Bluff High School to 5 straight State Championships (started as an 8th grader) from 2004-2008. Stovall was the quarterback for Hokes Bluff High School and earned Alabama All-State honors as a punter as well. Stovall was drafted in the 2nd round by the Atlanta Braves in the 2008 MLB Draft (64th overall in the draft) as a left-handed pitcher. He played 6 years of professional baseball before arriving on the Plains to play Auburn Football. In 2018 he received the Unsung Hero Award at Auburn University. While at Auburn University, Stovall obtained a Bachelor's degree in Business Marketing and a Master's degree in Exercise Science with a focus in Biomechanics. He spends time speaking at churches and other events about his faith, and how he would be nothing without the love and grace of God.

BASKETBALL (CO-ED) Instructor: Tommy Murr and NE AL area middle & high school coaches

A legend in the state of Alabama, Murr attended Lindsay Lane Christian Academy (Athens, AL) where he was coached by his father - Steve Murr. Murr ended his career as the Alabama High School Athletic Association's all-time leading scorer with 5,716 points. He signed a scholarship with Lipscomb University and transferred to the University of Alabama, Huntsville last year. He is now a Senior and plays guard.

Coach Wyman attended Carlmont High School in Belmont, CA, the College of San Mateo in San Mateo, CA before transferring to Kentucky State University (an HBCU). Coach Wyman was drafted in the 6th round (206th overall) of the 1996 NFL Draft by the New England Patriots. Prior to the 1999 NFL season the defensive tackle signed with the Minnesota Vikings and was allocated to NFL Europe to play for the Barcelona Dragons. Wyman signed with the Kansas City Chiefs in 2002, but did not play that season and left the team. On March 30, 2015 he was named head coach for the Texas Revolution of the Champions Indoor Football League. Devin Wyman has served with FCA sport camps for over a decade.
