JOB



- Interns will lead, love, train and teach all volunteer huddle leaders and campers by setting an example for all of the Believers (1 Timothy 4:12).
- Interns will lead volunteer huddle leaders and campers in daily tasks throughout the summer by displaying the spirit of a foot-washer (John 13).
- Interns should always be the first to give help to others on the team and last to receive.
- Interns mentality should be first to arrive and last to leave.
- Interns should recruit a minimum of 1-3 volunteer huddle leaders per camp and leadership conferences.
- Interns lead with the campers' hearts and minds always as priority.
- Interns will be supported and supervised by our Summer and Honorary Captain Interns, plus the NE AL FCA staff.

SALARY



- Base pay of \$200/week
- Pay will be increased depending on number of years served with NE AL FCA as an Intern.
- One will serve a minimum of 3.5 weeks: The Spiritual Bootcamp (1.5 weeks), plus 2 of the 4 Sports Camp weeks.
- One can serve up to 5.5 weeks if he/she wants to do so.
- fundraising required by NE AL FCA Interns.

LODGING & MEALS



- Lodging will be provided for Interns, if needed. Contact Amy Thaxton by May 1, 2026 with your need.
- 1 meal, water, and snacks at Bootcamp.
- 2 meals/day, water, and post-camp snacks, at all power sports camps.

TIME OFF & FCA OFFICE CLOSED

- Sleep in your own bed, yet go on Mission this summer (PRICELESS).
- Attend your team practices/workout and still be able to serve on Mission (PRICELESS).
- Submit dates/times for absence to Coach Amy Thaxton (athaxton@fca.org) by May 27 for pre-approval.
- The requests will be addressed case-by-case.
- CPR Certification (required, and you will be reimbursed up to \$50).
- FCA SPIRIT PACK which includes: t-shirts, Bible, notebook, books, transportation, etc. (\$600 value).
- Serve at the Power Leadership Training (PLT) Middle School Conference: July 30-31 (20 volunteer hours).
- Attend Power Leadership Training (PLT) High School Conference: August 7-8 for FREE (\$200 value).
- ALL siblings (ages 7-13) can attend Power Sports Camps at NO CHARGE (\$250 value per person per camp)
- All interns may attend Jekyll Island, GA Student Leadership Advance (SLA) at NO CHARGE (\$800+ value)
- NE AL FCA Administrative/Staff fee (PRICELESS)
- FCA National Support Center fee (\$350 value)

REQUIREMENT/ NOTES



- Must be a rising junior or senior in high school or older
- All Interns are REQUIRED to serve a TOTAL of 40 NE AL FCA volunteer hours, completed by August 25, 2026.
- **One will serve a minimum of 3.5 weeks:** The Spiritual Bootcamp (1.5 weeks), plus 2 of the 4 Sports Camp weeks.
- Interested Interns MUST complete STEP 2 by NOON on Monday, February 2 to begin interview process.
- The FCA Camp Leadership Team will be selecting all Summer Interns.
- A LIMITED NUMBER of INTERNS will be SELECTED.
