Top 10 Things To Know

- 1. We serve 5 counties: Madison, Marshall, Cullman, Jackson and Blount.
- 2. We are aware of an FCA Huddle Ministry on over 80 campuses and continue to see It grow.
- 3. Multiple Community Ministry opportunities such as: PLT Party, Golf Tournaments, Men's/Women's Huddles and an Iron Bowl Prayer Breakfast Tour which serves 3 major areas of NE AL in 3 counties in 3 days and host over 1000 people.
- 4. FOUR summer outreach Sports Camps had over 800 kids participate in Summer 2025 (ages 7-13).
- 5.Our Summer 2025 Internship Ministry included 58 high school and college students.
- 6. The Power Leadership Training (PLT) Conference (Middle & High School), ministered to over 600 students, coaches and adult volunteers.
- 7. During the school year, our team faithfully serves at the Huntsville Learning Center during PE time, building relationships and sharing God's love through sports.
- 8. The Coach & Spouse Marriage Enrichment Weekend served over 25 couples. Our next one will be in January 2026.
- 9. Hundreds of chapels and team devotions occur across the Northeast Alabama area annually.
- 10. The NE AL FCA influence is estimated to impact thousands of students and hundreds of coaches each year. (There are over 114,740 students in our NE AL area, grades K-12 and college).
