## VOLLEYBALL (GIRLS)

**Instructors:** **Christie Brothers** and NE AL area middle & high school coaches

Cristie Brothers was hired as Geraldine's volleyball coach in 1997, she built a state powerhouse over 21 seasons, winning 14 county titles, 16 area championships, making 12 Final 8 appearances, earning two state runner-up finishes, and capturing the 2001 Class 2A State Championship. She recorded her 800th win in 2016—becoming just the 15th coach in Alabama history to do so—and finished with an 872–346 record, averaging 41.5 wins per season. Her 2006 team set a school record with 59 wins, and 27 of her players went on to play at the collegiate level. Since 2018, she has coached at Snead State, becoming head coach in 2022.

## 13 YEAR OLD "GAP" HUDDLES

**Camp mornings remain the same with sport instruction; however, the afternoons will be extraordinary for the 13 year -old as they participate in the following types of activities:**

- **Soccer Golf**

**In addition to the above, 13 year-old campers will serve as assistant huddle leaders for younger campers for 1 day of camp. This will help them bridge the GAP between sports camp and FCA Middle and High School Camps. No additional funds are required for this experience. ## Food

Lunch and water will be provided to each camper. Daily lunch menu is available at [northalabamafca.org](http://northalabamafca.org) Campers are welcome to bring their own lunch, if desired. **Dietary Needs:** Please direct food allergies and medicine to the nurse. **All medicine should be placed in a ziplock bag with the camper's name on it and turned into the camp nurse.**

## Equipment

**Players are expected to bring their own equipment. Please contact us if you are unable to secure equipment. (Baseball: glove & bat; soccer: shinguards - optional; fishing: fishing pole; softball: glove & bat; swimming: swimsuit and towel; tennis - racquet.)** If your child's sport is not listed, there is no equipment needed. **Please put your child's name on ALL items.** Each camper must provide their own shoes, socks, shorts and t-shirts.

## Check-In

Check-in each morning will be at [Sand Mountain Park](#). Parents are not required to come in with your child. **8:00AM is the earliest a camper can be dropped off. Please do not drop off or pick up your camper at his/her sport location without checking in with the FCA camp office.**

## Pick-Up & Check-Out

The **car pick-up sign** is included for you to visibly place in the **front window (on the driver's side of the vehicle)**. The car sign or picture ID is **mandatory** for camper pick-up. Allow a **10-minute buffer** when you arrive to check your child out as it takes time to get them from their huddle. **All early check-outs must be before 2:30PM.** If you arrive after 2:30PM, we will direct you to the carline for pick-up.

## Safety

- **Cell phones are discouraged. If you feel your camper must have a cell phone, please advise him/her it should not be used without permission of an FCA huddle leader.**
- **A Athletic Trainer is on duty at all times.** Because of the rigorous schedule, each camper should come to camp in good physical condition. No flip flops or athletic sandals allowed.
- Due to the number of campers and planned schedules, **personal camper phone calls are not allowed**, except in the case of an emergency.
- In the case of an emergency, call/text the **FCA Camp Office at 256-509-3692.**
- **Any serious violation of camp rules or regulations could result in immediate dismissal from camp.** There will be no refund in this situation.

## BASEBALL (BOYS) Instructors: Tyler Stovall and NE AL area middle & high school coaches



Tyler Stovall, founder of Stovall Athletics, was a three sport athlete at Hokes Bluff High School in Alabama from 2004-2008 and graduated as class Valedictorian. He represented his country by playing for Team USA in the 2007 Pan Am games (USA baseball's National team). Stovall was Louisville Slugger's national Pitcher of the Year, Gatorade Player of the Year, and Alabama's Mr. Baseball. Stovall holds 8 AHSAA records for hitting and pitching with one being a national record. Stovall led Hokes Bluff High School to 5 straight State Championships (started as an 8th grader) from 2004-2008. Stovall was the quarterback for Hokes Bluff High School and earned Alabama All-State honors as a punter as well. Stovall was drafted in the 2nd round by the Atlanta Braves in the 2008 MLB Draft (64th overall in the draft) as a left-handed pitcher. He played 6 years of professional baseball before arriving on the Plains to play Auburn Football. In 2018 he received the Unsung Hero Award at Auburn University. While at Auburn University, Stovall obtained a Bachelor's degree in Business Marketing and a Master's degree in Exercise Science with a focus in Biomechanics. He spends time speaking at churches and other events about his faith, and how he would be nothing without the love and grace of God.
