


50CCER (CO-ED)

TRACK & FIELD (CO-ED) Instructors: David Cain and NE AL area middle & high school coaches

David Cain is now in his 27th season as head coach of the UAH men's and women's cross country and track and field programs, assuming his role back in 1998. During Cain's tenure in Huntsville, he has established UAH as one of the premier cross country programs in Division II, and one of the most respectable track and field programs in the region. Cain, having built the track and field program from the ground up, led the men's and women's track and field programs to their back-to-back Peach Belt Conference titles in 2013 and 2014 prior to competing in the GSC in spring 2017. Since joining the GSC, Cain has guided the men's squad to back-to-back championships while accumulating a total of 10 All-Americans over the past two seasons. A native of Huntsville, Cain graduated from Grissom High School where he lettered in track and cross country. His senior season he was named All-City and All-State in both sports, and finished second in the state in the two mile race. Coach Cain was inducted into the Madison County Hall of Fame in 2023.

13 YEAR OLD "GAP" HUDDLES

Camp mornings remain the same with sport instruction, however, the afternoons will be extraordinary for the 13 year -old as they participate in the following:

Lunch and water will be provided to each camper. Daily lunch menu is available at northalabamafca.org Campers are welcome to bring their own lunch, if desired. Dietary Needs: Please direct food allergies and medicine to the camp trainer.

All medicine should be placed in a ziplock bag with the camper's name on it and turned into the athletic trainer.



Players are expected to bring their own equipment. Please contact us if you are unable to secure equipment. (Baseball: glove & bat; fishing: fishing: pole: qolf: golf clubs: lacrosse: lacrosse stick; soccer; shinquards - optional; softball: glove & bat: tennis - racquet.) If your child's sport is not listed, there is no equipment needed. Please put your child's name on ALL items. Each camper must provide their own shoes, socks, shorts and t-shirts.



Check-In

Check-in each morning will be at Whitesburg Baptist Church (ROC). Parents are not required to come in with your child. 8:00AM is the earliest a camper can be dropped off. Please do not drop off or pick up your camper at his/her sport location without checking in with the FCA camp office.



Pick-Up & Check-Out

The car pick-up sign is included for you to visibly place in the front window (on the drivers side of the vehicle) as you pick up your child in the specified car line. The car sign or picture ID is mandatory for camper pick-up. Allow a 10-minute buffer when you arrive to check your child out as it takes time to get them from their huddle. All early check-outs must be before 2:30PM. If you arrive after 2:30PM, we will direct you to the carline for pick-up. *NOTE: \$25 fee per family for campers picked up after 3:55pm. \$1 for every additional minute after 3:55pm*



- Cell phones are discouraged. If you feel your camper must have a cell phone, please advise him/her it should not be used without permission of an FCA huddle leader.
- An Athletic Trainer provided by Huntsville Hospital Sport Center is on duty at all times. Because of the rigorous schedule, each camper should come to camp in good physical condition. No flip flops or athletic sandals allowed.
- Due to the number of campers and planned schedules, **personal camper phone calls are not allowed**, except in the case of an emergency.
- In the case of an emergency, call/text the FCA Camp Office at 256-509-3692.
- · Any serious violation of camp rules or regulations could result in immediate dismissal from camp. There will be no refund in this situation.
