NASSAU COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD SCHEDULE FOR THE 2026 GENERAL ELECTION

Nassau County, FL 9/9/26 The Nassau County Supervisor of Elections office announces the 2026 General Election Canvassing Board Schedule. The Canvassing board will meet on October 1, 2026, to conduct the Logic & Accuracy Test of ballot scanners that will be used during the 2026 General Election. Pursuant to F.S. 102.141(2)(a) all Canvassing Board meetings are open to the public.

Important Dates for the General Election:

New Registration Deadline: October 5

Deadline to Request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot: October 22

Early Voting: October 22 – October 31, 9 AM – 6 PM

Election Day: November 3, 7 AM – 7 PM
