NASSAU COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD SCHEDULE FOR THE 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION

Nassau County, FL 6/25/26 The Nassau County Supervisor of Elections office announces the 2026 Primary Election Canvassing Board Schedule. The Canvassing board will meet on July 23, 2026, to conduct the Logic & Accuracy Test of ballot scanners that will be used during the 2026 Primary Election. Pursuant to F.S. 102.141(2)(a) all Canvassing Board meetings are open to the public.

Important Dates for the Primary Election:

New Registration and Party Change Deadline: July 20

Deadline to Request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot: August 6

Early Voting: August 6 – August 15, 9 AM – 6 PM

Election Day: August 18, 7 AM – 7 PM

August 22, 2026 (If needed)	9 am	Conduct machine recount ordered and certify second unofficial results. Conduct manual recount (If needed) (F.S. 102.141, FAC Rule 1S-2.031) [F.S. 102.141(7)(c), 102.166, 102.112]
August 24, 2026	2 pm	Perform post-election audit of voting system. Certify official election results. [F.S. 102.141(10)(a), FAC Rule 1S-5.026]
