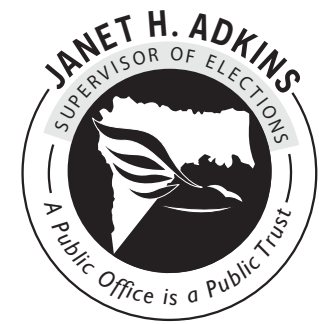

August 13, 2026 9:30 AM	Open and canvass mail ballots. Scan mail ballots into Independent Audit System. [F.S. 101.68(2), FAC R1S-5.026]
August 17, 2026 9:30 AM	Open mail ballots. Scan early vote ballots into Independent Audit System. [F.S. 101.68(2), FAC R1S-5.026]
August 18, 2026	Election Day- 3:30 PM Open and canvass mail ballots. Scan ballots into Independent Audit System. [F.S. 101.68(2), 101.6925, FAC R1S-5.026] Election Day- 7:00 PM [F.S.102.141(4)(a)] Release unofficial results (does not include provisional ballots).
August 19, 2026 9:30 AM	Scan ballots into Independent Audit System.
August 20, 2026	9:30 AM - Scan ballots into Independent Audit System. 4:00 PM - Canvass provisional ballots & vote by mail cures. Certify first unofficial election results. [F.S. 101.048, 101.68(4)(b), 102.141(5)]
August 21, 2026 9:30 AM	Pre-sort ballots to prepare for recount ordered. (If needed.) Adjudicate unreadable cards in the Independent Audit System. [F.S. 102.141(7)(c), FAC R1S-5.026]
August 22, 2026 9:00 AM (If needed)	Conduct machine recount ordered and certify second unofficial results. Conduct manual recount (if needed) (F.S. 102.121, FAC Rule 1S-2.031) [F.S. 102.141(7)(c), 102.166, 102.112]
August 24, 2026 2:00 PM	Perform post- election audit of voting system. Certify official election results. [F.S. 102.141(10)(a), FAC Rule R1S -5.026]

The Nassau County Canvassing Board may convene at other times as deemed necessary. For schedule updates, please visit www.VoteNassauFL.gov/Notices. Refer to each meeting agenda for specific activities. The Nassau County Supervisor of Elections will use Clear Audit, if available, to facilitate post-election audits and any required recounts. Election staff will scan ballots into the recount/audit tabulation system in advance of the audit and any potential recounts.

Anyone who casts a provisional ballot has two days after the election to provide proof of eligibility to the Canvassing Board. The deadline for this election is August 20, 2026, at 5 PM. [F.S. 101.048]

NOTE: Persons are advised that if they wish to appeal any decision made at these meetings, they will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose they may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based, per Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes.
