Page Governmental Complex, 96135 Nassau Place, Tabulation Room/Conference Room A, Yulee, at the dates and times below. Refer to each meeting agenda for specific activities. The Nassau County Supervisor of Elections will use Clear Audit, if available, to facilitate post-election audits and any required recounts. Election staff will scan ballots into the recount/audit tabulation system in advance of the audit and any potential recounts, as indicated below.
