



2026 Primary Canvassing Board Meeting
Minutes for Logic and Accuracy Test
July 23, 2026, at 1:00 pm

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Commissioner Klynt Farmer. The meeting was held in the Canvassing Board Room, James S. Page Governmental Complex, 96135 Nassau Place, Yulee, Florida.

Commissioner Farmer reviewed the list of signees in attendance and verified that all persons had signed in and received badges.

Supervisor Adkins presented the proofs of publication reflecting that the meeting had been publicly noticed in the News-Leader and the Nassau County Record on June 24, 2026, and posted on the Nassau County Supervisor of Elections website at www.VoteNassauFL.gov and the main entrance of the building.

During the public's opportunity to speak, no members of the public who were present requested to speak.

Minutes from the July 1, 2026, Canvassing Board meeting were presented. A motion to accept the minutes was made and seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

The Test Plan outlining the process for the Logic and Accuracy Test was presented. The test plan identified the random voting equipment and the schema to be used for testing. A motion to adopt the Test Plan was made and seconded. The motion carried unanimously. The testing was then performed by the Tabulation Team, and reports were presented to the Canvassing Board members for review and approval.

Canvassing Board members reviewed and confirmed that the predetermined results matched the results of the Logic and Accuracy Test, and signed the certification documents and reports of the Logic and Accuracy

Tests. It was noted that DS300 12A failed to transmit results. The Canvassing Board deemed the tabulation results satisfactory and approved this equipment for use in the 2026 Primary Election.

All testing materials and reports were sealed in a security bag with Seal No. 145009. The testing materials are secured in the Canvassing Board room with 24-hour camera surveillance and a security alarm. The parameters used in the Public Test will be uploaded to the Florida Division of Elections.

Commissioner Farmer reviewed the upcoming Canvassing Board Meeting dates for any scheduling conflicts.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:27pm.
