



2026 Primary Canvassing Board Meeting
Minutes for Meeting to Scan Election Day and Vote by Mail Ballots
August 19, 2026, at 9:30 am

Supervisor Adkins reviewed the list of signees in attendance and verified that all persons had signed in and been issued badges.

The Elections Team commenced scanning of Election Day ballots into the Independent Audit System.
