



2026 Primary Canvassing Board Meeting
Minutes for Meeting to Adjudicate Unreadable Ballots
August 21, 2026, at 9:30 am

Supervisor Adkins reviewed the list of signees in attendance and verified that all persons had signed in and had been issued badges.

Meeting attendees were advised that it is a felony offense to disclose any information relating to how ballots are voted that is observed during the meeting.
