Please be sure your child has the tools he or she needs for a successful beginning to the school year. **Label everything** with your child's name. Thank you for your cooperation.

- **Crayola CRAYONS** primary colors 24 pack (purchase several)
Crayons need replacing many times throughout the school year.
- **Fiskars SCISSORS** for children (that your child is comfortable using)
- (2) **Elmer's GLUE STICKS**
- (2) **Elmer's white GLUE BOTTLES**
- Washable **MARKERS**
- Plastic pencil/crayon box
- (2) **COMPOSITION BOOKS**
- (2) **FOLDERS** glossy or poly with **bottom pockets** (NOT side pockets)
- 2 cans of **PLAY-DOH**
- **BACKPACK** (large enough to hold pocket folders)
- **Adult t-shirt** used as an art smock (Do Not send a plastic smock with ties and velcro)
- 2 1-gallon size **ziploc baggies** (2 baggies NOT 2 boxes)
- 2 Canisters or packages of antibacterial **HAND WIPES**
- 1 Canister of antibacterial **CLEANING WIPES**
- 1 box of **TISSUES**
- **Headphones - COMPATIBLE with Chromebooks** that your child is comfortable using
- **Large 32 qt. clear bin with lid** that your child can open and close. **This bin will be used to store your child's textbooks/workbooks, composition books, writing journal, snacks for the week, school supplies, and other belongings.** The 32qt. *Rubbermaid* or any brand of a **similar size** will work.
