Auto Mechanics / Small Engine Teacher (Secondary - CTE)

Position Overview

We are seeking a qualified and motivated Auto Mechanics / Small Engine Teacher to join our Career and Technical Education program. The successful candidate will provide hands-on instruction in automotive technology and prepare students for post-secondary education, industry certifications, and entry-level employment in the automotive field. Collaboration with local post-secondary institutions and community partners is a key responsibility. Instruction must align with standards established by the Utah State Board of Education.

- Deliver engaging classroom and shop-based instruction in automotive technology / small engine repair.
 - Teach engine repair, brakes, steering & suspension, electrical systems, diagnostics, and preventative maintenance
 - Prepare students for industry certifications, including the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE)
 - Maintain a safe and organized automotive lab environment
 - Supervise students during hands-on lab activities
 - Assess student learning through written and performance-based evaluations
 - Maintain accurate student records and grades
 - Collaborate with local industry partners for internships and work-based learning
 - Support student participation in SkillsUSA
 - Participate in faculty meetings and professional development
 - Collaborate with post-secondary institutions

- Valid Utah Educator License with CTE endorsement in Automotive Technology (or ability to obtain through alternative licensure pathway)
- Minimum 4,000 hours of verified industry experience in automotive repair
- Strong knowledge of modern automotive systems and diagnostic tools
- Ability to manage a classroom and shop environment safely

- ASE Certification(s)
 - Prior teaching or training experience
 - Experience working with high school students

 - Requires standing for extended periods
