You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected. We may charge for our services in buying these items.

## Cremation Services

A common misconception is that cremation prevents the possibility of holding a funeral service or visitation. This is not true; you can still have a memorial service to celebrate your loved one's life, with many options available for honoring their memory. After cremation, you can choose from various final disposition methods:

- **Interment:** Bury or entomb your loved one's cremated remains in a family plot, memorial site, cremation niche, or urn garden. Consult our staff for detailed interment options.
- **Graveside Service:** Similar to traditional burial, this service allows loved ones to honor the deceased during the burial of the cremated remains with prayers and tributes.
- **Scattering:** Spread the cremated remains in a memorial garden, cemetery, over water, or any meaningful location. You may also choose to scatter some remains while retaining the rest in an urn for interment.
- **Multiple Urns:** Distribute the cremated remains into several urns, enabling family members separated by distance to have a nearby resting place for their loved one.
- These options allow for meaningful tributes that reflect the individuality of your loved one.

## Burial Services

We offer a variety of burial services tailored to your individual needs and preferences:

- **Immediate Burial:** The loved one is buried or entombed without a public service.
- **Visitation (Viewing/Wake):** Family and friends gather with the deceased in an open or closed casket to offer support and say goodbye.
- **Funeral or Memorial Service:** Held at a funeral home, church, or home, these personalized ceremonies celebrate and honor the deceased's life.
- **Graveside, Chapel, or Committal Service:** Conducted at the cemetery, this service allows family and friends to witness the final disposition through ground burial.

## Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff (and overhead) -----

**\$2,895**

Our charge includes funeral counseling, necessary arrangements, recording vital statistics, securing permits, filing and obtaining death certificates and other forms and claims, preparation of necessary notices, coordination of service plans with parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased, necessary administrative, accounting, and clerical services. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.

## Preparation of Deceased

### Embalming ----- **\$995**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation / immediate disposition or burial.

- Dressing, casketing and/or cosmetics ----- **\$395**
- Special care for autopsied cases and/or organ donation ----- **\$470**
- Special care for obese cases (over 300lbs) ----- **\$295**
- Minimum sanitary care ----- **\$415**

## **DIRECT CREMATION ----- \$2,655 to \$17,440**

Our charge for direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: local transfer of deceased to the funeral home, refrigeration in lieu of embalming, basic service of funeral director and staff, obtaining necessary permits and authorizations, transportation to Washington County Crematorium, crematorium fee, medical examiners release, and permit. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of heavy cardboard, wood, fiberboard or other composite materials.

- **Direct Cremation** with container provided by family ----- **\$2,655**  
All such containers / caskets must meet any applicable state, cemetery or crematory requirements
- **Direct Cremation** with basic cremation container (cardboard) ----- **\$2,795**
- **Direct Cremation** with transporter (corrugated fiberboard) ----- **\$3,040**
- **Direct Cremation** with Harmony (corrugated fiberboard) ----- **\$3,340**

## **IMMEDIATE BURIAL ----- \$4,680 to \$19,675**

Our charges for an immediate burial include: basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, transportation to cemetery, and dressing deceased and/or casketing. This charge does not include merchandise, vaults, embalming, rites or ceremonies, cemetery fees or other third party charges.

- **Immediate Burial** with casket provided by family ----- **\$4,680**  
All such containers / caskets must meet any applicable state, cemetery or crematory requirements
- **Immediate Burial** with minimum casket from our funeral home ----- **\$6,575**

## **FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME ----- \$4,685**

This charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, embalming and obtaining necessary permits (but not the actual cost of death certificates or permits). It does not include a casket, alternative container, shipping container or any other merchandise, rite or ceremonies, transportation to the airport, or any other third party charges.

## **RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME ----- \$3,490**

This charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff, obtaining necessary permits and authorizations (but not the actual cost of permits), and local transportation to the cemetery. It does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, dressing/casketing or cosmetics, transferring the remains from the airport or other source, or any third party charges.

## **CHILDREN SERVICES**

\*The price structure below refers to the basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, other preparation of body, use of facilities, staff and equipment, and automotive equipment.

Our firm has established a uniform payment policy to serve all families fairly and to alleviate misunderstandings. A sound credit policy enables us to contain our costs to the families we serve. As a small business providing services and merchandise, we are totally dependent upon our clients for prompt payment. **Assignable Life Insurance:**

Life insurance may be used as a means of full or partial payment for funeral and other related expenses. A fee of \$415 per policy will be charged and reflected on your statement of goods and services as an “insurance assignment fee.”

We regret that we are unable to accept settlement of estates through attorneys or probate court as a means of financial arrangements. All unpaid balances from the date of service accrue a finance charge of 2% per month (24% per year).
