

# Contraceptive Visit Checklist

## Check for patient eligibility

18+

- Is the patient 18 years or older?
- Has the patient received **no more than** a 12 month supply of hormonal contraceptives from a pharmacist without evaluation by another provider (e.g. primary care provider, women's health provider, etc.)

If NO to either question, counsel patient on OTC contraception options and refer the patient to their women's health provider or primary care provider.

**If YES to both questions, proceed to the next step.**

## Patient fills out self-screener form



## Assess patient blood pressure

- Pharmacist or trained technician can check and record the blood pressure.



## Select a contraceptive product

- Check patient self-screener and blood pressure for contraindications using the **U.S. MEC** to determine which hormonal contraceptives are appropriate



## Ask screening questions to reasonably rule out pregnancy



## Prescribe no more than a 6 month supply

- The pharmacist is the prescriber of record.



## Provide patient with a written record of the method prescribed



## Refer patient to PCP or women's health provider if they do not have one



## Notify patient's PCP and/or women's health provider of prescription, if patient permits
