

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA**

**January 18, 2022**

The City Council of the City of Homewood, Alabama convened in Special Session on Monday, January 18, 2022 at City Hall at 5:15 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by President Wyatt at 5:18 p.m.
