

RESOLUTION NO. 23 - 111

WHEREAS, the Alabama legislature in Act No. 2019-2 adopted the Rebuild Alabama Act; and

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act provides for an allocation among the municipalities of the state on the basis of the ratio of population of each municipality to the total population of all municipalities of the state a portion of the additional taxes levied under the Act to be used for transportation infrastructure, improvement, preservation and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the municipal governing body of the City of Homewood shall adopt an annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31 which shall provide a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year and shall be based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund in which the additional revenue is deposited during the next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Act further provides that any such funds shall be used only for the maintenance, improvement, replacement, and construction of roads and bridges maintained by the City of Homewood and such other uses as are defined in the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Homewood, Alabama, at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

1. That the City Council does by the adoption of this resolution pass this Resolution as its Transportation Plan submitted in compliance with the Rebuild Act, Act No. 2019-2.
2. That the City Council of the City of Homewood, pursuant to the Act, estimates that its anticipated allocation from the Rebuild Alabama Act fund for this fiscal year will be approximately \$198,338 with increasing allocations for each fiscal year thereafter.
3. That the City Council of the City of Homewood, pursuant to the Act, anticipates expending funds received pursuant to the Act, in part or in whole, to fund any of the following listed projects:

4. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to post a copy of this Resolution as its Transportation Plan in a conspicuous place at the City Municipal Hall and also on the website of the City of Homewood.

5. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to establish a separate fund maintained by the City of Homewood for receipt and deposit of funds received pursuant to the Act, the proceeds of which shall be expended solely for the maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and bridges maintained by the City and such other uses as are authorized by the Act.


6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Homewood City Council.
