ORDINANCE NO. 2944

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT, NOTIFICATION AND COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS TO HOLD THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION CALLED FOR AUGUST 26, 2025, AND A RUNOFF ELECTION TO BE HELD, IF NECESSARY, ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2025

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. That, pursuant to the provisions of Ala. Code §§ 11-46-24 and 11-46-27 (1975), the following named persons be and they are hereby appointed as officers to hold the regular municipal election heretofore called for August 26, 2025, and a runoff election to be held, if necessary, on September 23, 2525, in the City of Homewood, Alabama, namely:

Section 2. That the Chief of Police is authorized and directed to reserve parking placed during the hours that polls are open for voting, to be used exclusively by voters at the Ward voting place at Homewood City Hall, First Floor, which spaces shall be adjacent to the rear of Homewood City Hall in the surface parking lot.
Section 3. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to publish or caus to be published a list of the election officers appointed as aforesaid and the voting places for which said officers have been appointed by posting same at three (3) public places in the City of Homewood at least ten (10) days prior to said election.
Section 4. That the Mayor shall notify, or cause to be notified, each of the officer named in Section 1 hereof of their appointment, which said notice shall be served upon them by the Chief of Police or by any police officer of the City of Homewood, Alabama.
Section 5. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to pay, or cause to be paid, out of the general funds of the City the fees set by the Acts of the Legislature for the State of Alabama for elections held in Jefferson County, Alabama, for the same or similar election officials and the election of officers herein appointed on proper proof of service rendered by said officers at said election.
Section 6. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to hold, or cause to be held, a school of instruction for the officers appointed to conduct said municipal election. The City Clerk is further directed to notify such officers of the time and place of holding such school of instruction and to publish notice thereof in the manner prescribed by law at least forty-eight (48) hours before such school is held.
Section 7. That the Chief of Police, pursuant to and in the manner prescribed by Ala Code § 11-46-28(i) (1975), shall preserve good order at said municipal election.
Section 8. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, approval by the Mayor, or as otherwise becoming law.
