

ORDINANCE NO. 2954

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA; TO LIMIT PARKING ON OR ALONG A PORTION OF OXMOOR ROAD, THE CITY LOT ON OXMOOR ROAD AND ON ST CHARLES STREET AND A PORTION OF BOARDWAY STREET IN THE CITY OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA; AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Homewood as follows:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park, or permit to be parked, a motor vehicle, motorcycle or other motorized vehicle, as defined in the Highway Code of the State of Alabama (1975), on or along the public right of way portion of Oxmoor Road between the intersection of Evergreen Avenue with Oxmoor Road and Peerless Avenue with Oxmoor Road, and in the City owned Public Parking lots on Oxmoor and St Charles Street as described in Exhibit A, within the city limits of the City of Homewood, Alabama for a period of time in excess of two consecutive hours. +

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park, or permit to be parked, a motor vehicle, motorcycle or other motorized vehicle, as defined in the Highway Code of the State of Alabama (1975), on or along a portion of Broadway Street as described in Exhibit A within the city limits of the City of Homewood, Alabama for a period of time in excess of two consecutive hours.


Section 3. That the violation of any section of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, and any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions thereof, on conviction, shall be punished as provided by Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Homewood adopted and approved by the City Council and Mayor of the City, or as the same may hereinafter be amended.

Section 4. The Chief of Police of said City shall erect, or cause to be erected, appropriate lines, markings, limited parking signs at the locations described in Sections 1 and 2 above.


Section 5. Prior Ordinances in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance, are specifically repealed by the enactment of this Ordinance.

Section 6. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Homewood, Alabama, or as otherwise becoming law.
